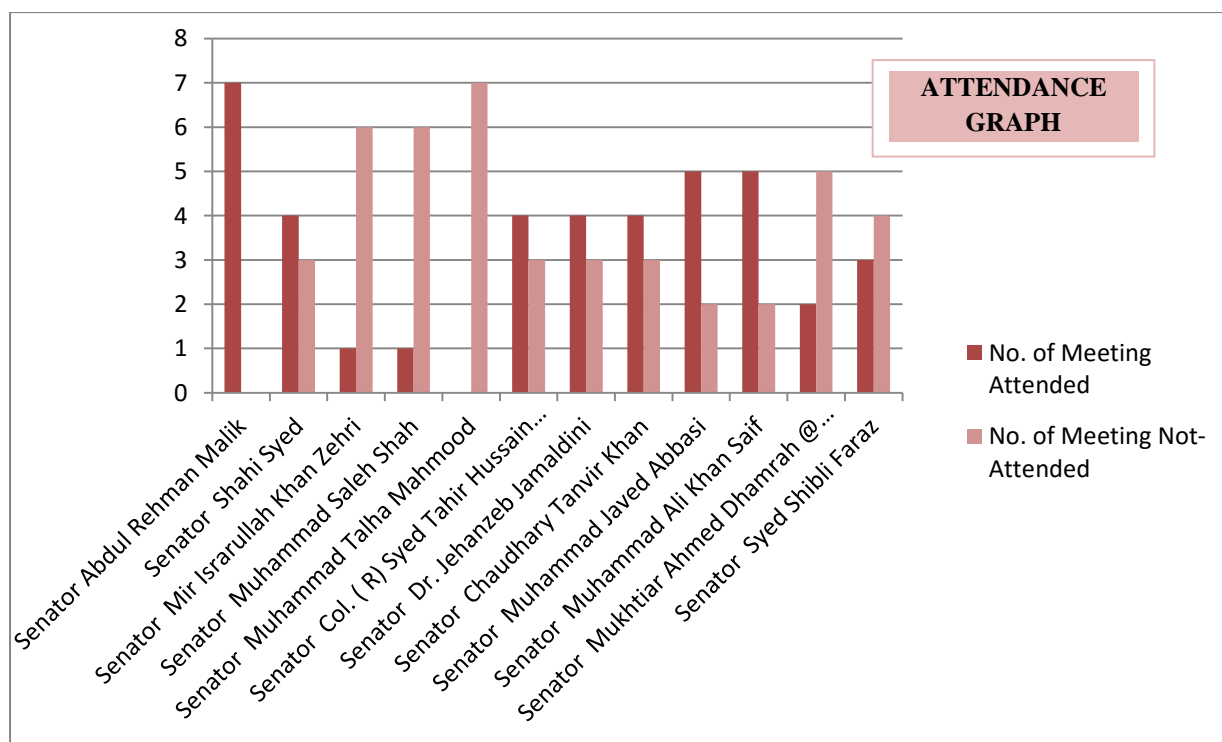

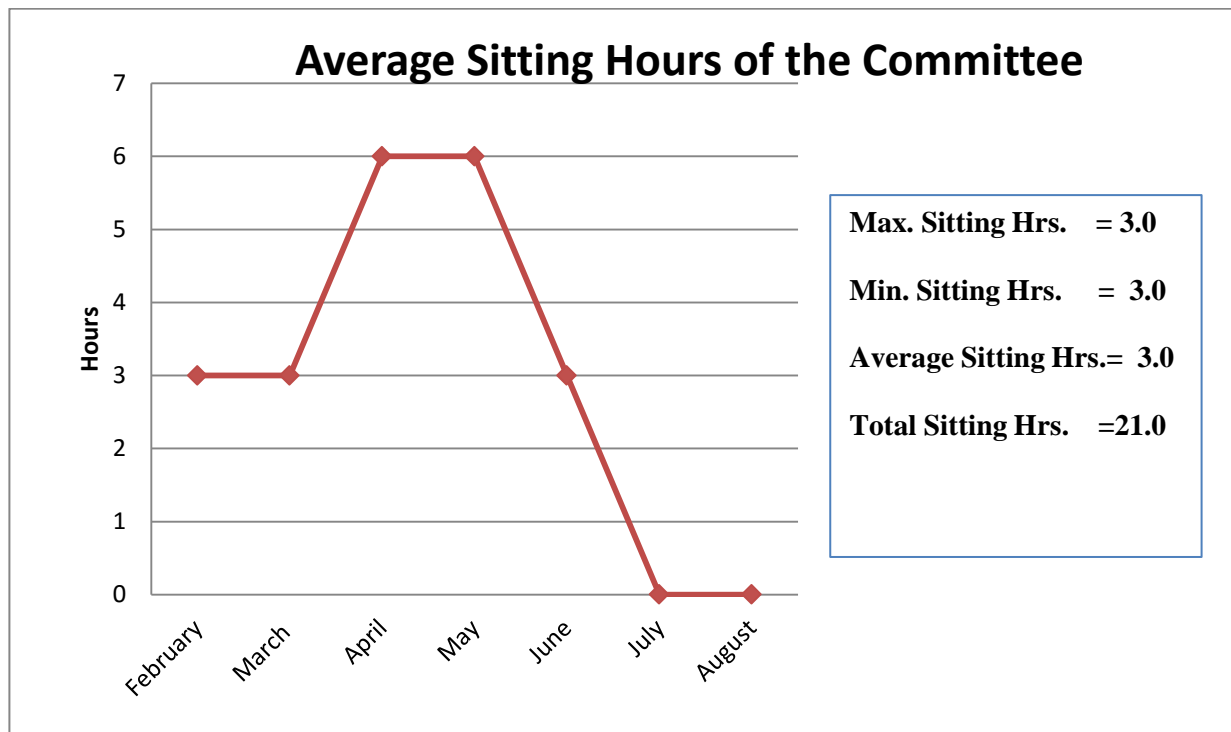

**9. Important Recommendations of the Committee:**

**1) Meeting held on 13-03-2017:**

- i. The Committee disposed of the PP-1686 with the note that the petitioner seemed dis-interested.

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- ii. The Public Petition No. 1745 was disposed of with the directions to NADRA that all the applicants desirous of seeking CNIC must be facilitated in all respects.
  - iii. On Agenda item No. (iii) the Committee directed that the Committee be kept informed of the progress of un-blocking the CNICs of Sulemankhail tribe.
  - iv. On Agenda item No. (iv) the Committee disposed of the Bill with the recommendations that the bill may not be passed.
  - v. On Agenda item No. (v) the Committee disposed the Bill with the recommendation that the Bill may be passed.
  - vi. On Agenda item No. (vi) the Committee disposed the Bill with the recommendation that the Bill may be passed.
  - vii. Both the Agenda item No. (vii) to (viii) were deferred till next meeting of the Standing Committee.
  - viii. On Agenda item No. (ix) the Committee disposed the Bill with the recommendation that the Bill may be passed.

NADRA authorities were also directed to submit the report on their agreement with Master Card Company. Under what direction the agreement was made and why was it repealed?
  - xi. Because of paucity of time, the Part-III could not be discussed and stood deferred. However, the Committee desired to visit the Quid-e-Azam University.

**2) Meeting held on 10-04-2017:**

- i. On Agenda item No.(i), the Committee disposed of the Bill with the recommendation that the Bill may not be passed and report be submitted to the House.
- ii. Agenda item No.(ii) was deferred till next meeting.
- iii. Agenda Item No.iii, the Committee disposed of the Bill with the recommendation that the Bill may not be passed and report be submitted to the House.
- iv. Agenda item No.iv, the Committee disposed of the Bill with the recommendation that the Bill may not be passed and report be submitted to the House.

**3) Meeting held on 18-04-2017:**

- i. Regarding heinous act of lynching and killing of Mashal Khan, the Committee directed the Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) for banning the content of torturing of Mashal Khan on social media.
- ii. The Chairman Committee proposed that CNIC should be made mandatory for making a facebook account to control false account.
- iii. The Committee recommended de-weaponing of all the Universities of the country and stressed upon the Federal Government as well as Provincial Governments for necessary legislation in this regard.

**4) Meeting held on 08-05-2017:**

- i. On Afghanistan-Pakistan border issue, the Committee recommended to bring Pakistan stance in the UN Security Council so that the situation in Afghanistan is explained before the International forum. Indian involvement should also be brought in the notice of UN Security Council with proper codified evidence.



- ii. On abduction of three political leaders Mr. NawabLaghari, Mr. AshfaqLaghari and Mr. Ghulam Qadir Marri, the Committee directed to submit report of this tragic incident in detail. The Committee also emphasised that the report should not be an eye-wash rather a proper report be submitted to the Committee within thirty working days. However, if the Committee is dis-satisfied with the report, the Committee will direct the three victims to appear before the Committee and record their statement.
- iii. The Committee appreciated the efforts done by Islamabad Police with respect to recovery of stolen vehicles.
- iv. The Committee directed the concerned Ministries, the Ministry of Interior and Ministry of Defence to give detailed briefing on the arrest of Ehsanullah Ehsan, a terrorist and also highlight the way of handling such terrorist in future.
- v. The Committee showed concerned on issuance of CNICS to Aliens and directed to bring strict law for such aliens who are having Pakistani CNICs. The Committee recommended to find out possibilities of integrating DNA with the CNIC data to get rid of such Aliens who are working as tools in the hands of our enemies.
- vi. The Committee decided to visit Quetta (Balochistan) to see the problems and also the menace of alien registration on Pakistan soil.
- vii. On the matter of Alien registration, the Committee recommended that Ministry should work in the same way as they handled the fake SIMs. Closing the fake SIMs is a commendable effort done by the Interior Ministry.

**5) Meeting held on 22-05-2017:**

- i. The Committee recommended deputing exclusive human resources and enhancing finances for security of the CPEC other than those passed through the Annual Budget.
- ii. Preference be given to the local people in appointment for the FC in Baluchistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Levies in Baluchistan and FATA.
- iii. The Committee recommended for provision of better training facilities to the FC and Levies in Baluchistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and to remove all the disparities which they face in their wages with other similar forces in other provinces.
- iv. The Committees recommended for unfreezing the salaries of Islamabad Police at the earliest.
- v. The Committee recommended special training courses for capacity building of FIA by providing them the state of the art equipment and transport, setting up forensic labs etc.
- vi. The Committee recommended that due course of Law should be followed on the arrest of Ehsanullah Ehsan and also recommended for an in-camera meeting on the issue so that proper interrogation report may be discussed at length.
- vii. On the issue of KalboshanYadev, the Committee recommended to send all proofs with documents to ICJ in order to strengthen our case. The Committee unanimously recommended that the case be processed under law of the land and the spy must meet the natural fate.
- viii. On the issue of Drugs recovered from the PIA plane, the Committee recommended for taking the issue to Interpol in order to find out truth and facts.

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**6) Meeting held on 02-06-2017:**

- i. The Committee recommended that the Illegal Dispossession (Amendment) Act, 2017 as passed by the National Assembly, may be passed by the House and a report to that effect be submitted to the House.
- ii. The Committee directed the FIA to initiate an inquiry on recovery of Narcotics from PIA planes and a report be submitted to the Committee within 15 working days. The Committee also recommended that the matter should be analyzed by legal branch of FIA and necessary action be initiated in light of the analysis by legal branch.
- iii. The Committee recommended to regulate the system of surveillance and checking through proper but strict SOPs.
- iv. The Committee directed the Authorities to unearth the complete network working for export of Narcotics in such a huge quantity which is not possible without connivance of the drug mafia presently working not only in Pakistan but also their foreign need to be identified.
- v. The Committee, while putting appreciation on record for the FIA Staff in detecting the three Afghan ladies travelling on fake passports, recommended for medals and letters of appreciation for the Staff.
- vi. The Committee while discussing the cyber crime against Senator Muhammad JavedAbbasi and Mr. Bilawal Bhutto Zardari, the Chairman Pakistan People's Party, Directed FIA to submit an inquiry report within 15 days.
- vii. The Committee directed the CPO Rawalpindi to arrest all those who are accused in the murder case registered under FIR No. 11 dated 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2017, in Police Station, Banni, Rawalpindi. An investigation report and the findings of the Police be submitted to the Committee within 15 working days.

**7) Meeting Held on 15-08-2017:**

- i. The Committee for appreciation letters and awards to all concerned officers/officials of ANF, FIA and Islamabad Police in connection with carrying out a successful operation in the vicinity of Quaid e Azam University and recovery of Drugs form PIA Planes.
- ii. The committee recommended that human resource be recruited in the ANF as per their requirement and for increase in budget of ANF
- iii. The Committee show concern on connivance of the officials working at the airports with the drug mafia. The committee directed to submit a report on the outcome of inquiries and disciplinary action taken against the officials. It also advised to formulate a stringent mechanism to check and control the facilitators of drug mafia.
- iv. The committee showed concern on the theft Case of medals of the renowned poet, Ahmed Faraz, who was a national hero. The Committee directed that the details of the case and progress thereon should be submitted by the IG Police Islamabad in the next meeting positively.
- v. The Committee directed FIA to correspond with Interpol for arresting all culprits who fled Afghanistan and who were involved in the theft case of medals from the house of Senator Shibli Faraz.
- vi. The Committee recommended for the enhancement of financial resources of FIA as oer their requirement.

- vii. The Committee directed that a detailed report be submitted regarding illegal housing societies in Islamabad and Committee be informed about the authority who has restored the accounts of illegal societies.
- viii. The Committee directed NAB to brief about high rises in Islamabad in the next meeting of standing Committee and the violations made by the owners.
- ix. The Committee directed FIA, Chief Commissioner Islamabad and chairman CDA for holding a joint meeting and suggesting stringent measures to save public from loot and plunder of housing societies.
- x. The Committee directed civil Aviation Authority to install the latest cameras at the Hangar area and control be given to Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) as well as other concerned agencies to make the surveillances mechanism better.
- xi. The Committee directed to inform the name of the teacher found involved in drug distribution within a school in next meeting and that he/she should be penalized according to law.
