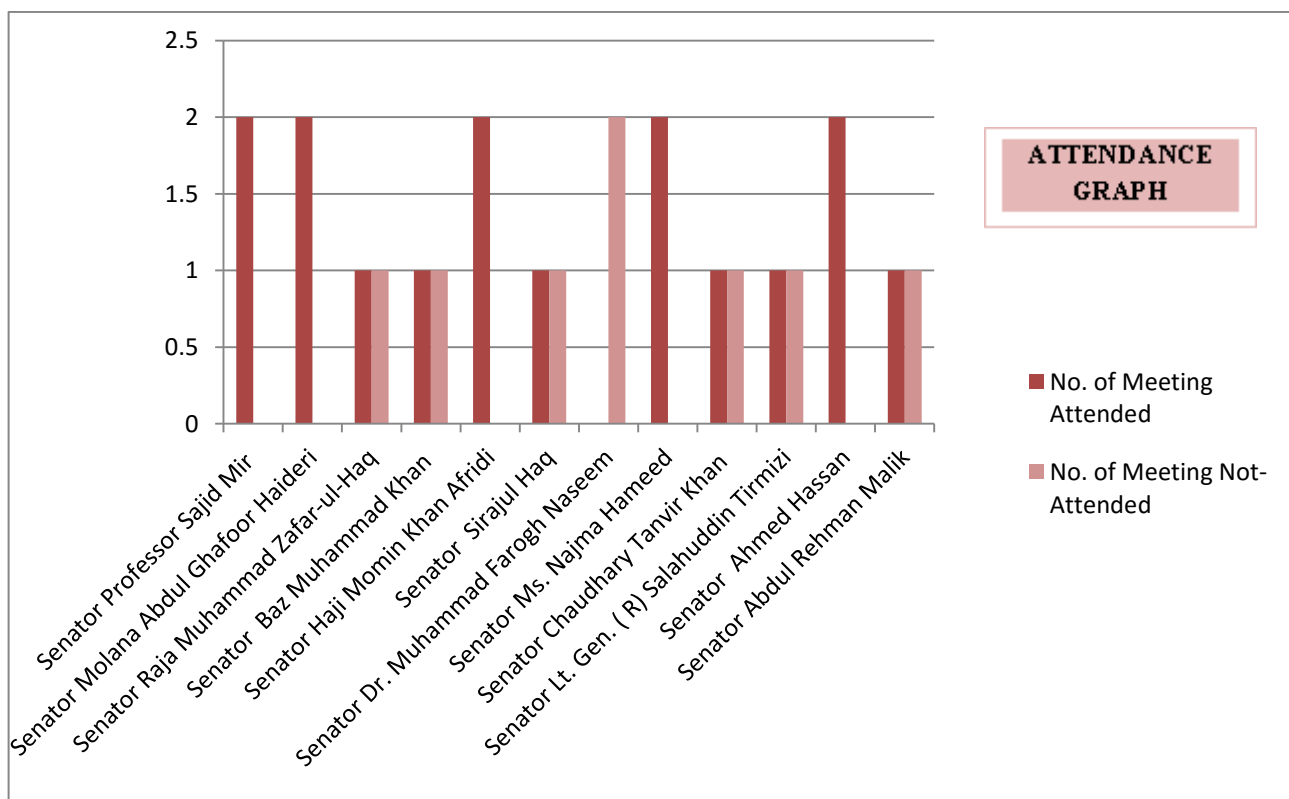

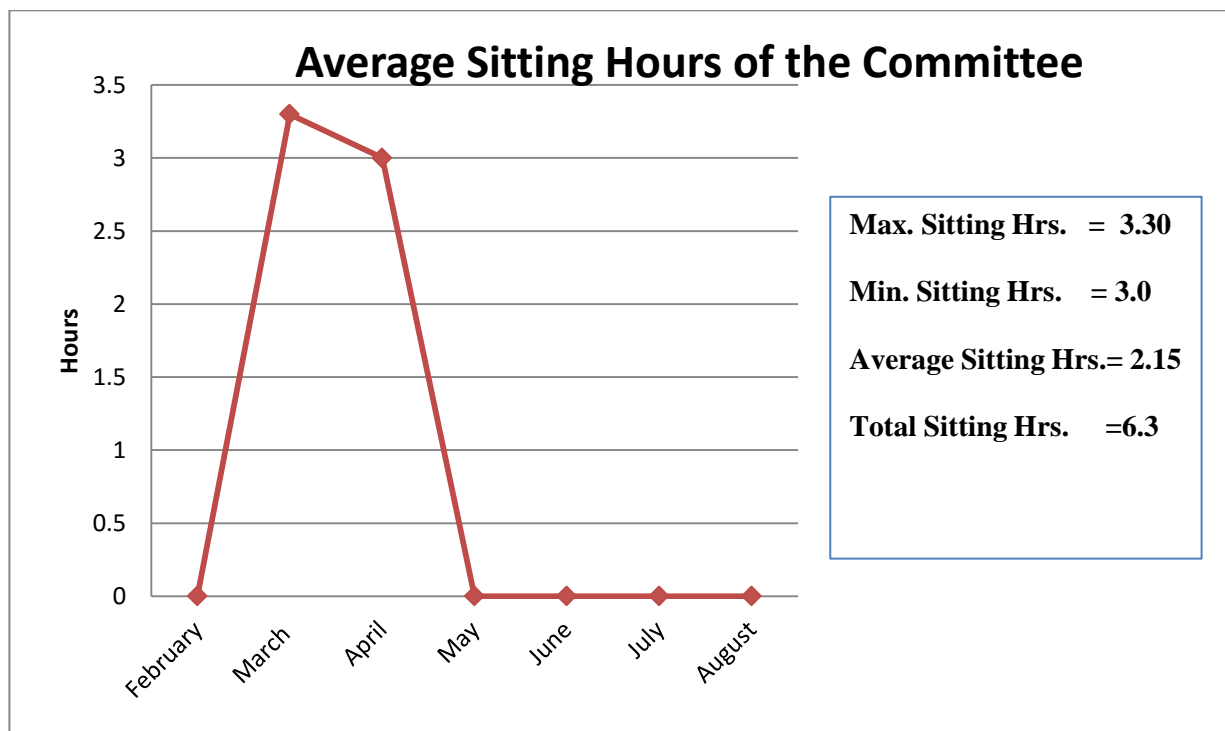

8. Agenda Items of the Meetings:

1) Meeting held on 15-03-2017:

- i. Briefing on the administration of Jammu and Kashmir State property in Pakistan its utilization, income and expenditure during the last year.
- ii. To follow-up the implementation status of the recommendations made by the Committee in its meeting held on 07-11-2016, especially comprehensive details on the recommendations No. (iii) regarding Petition of Syed Muzamil Shah, Ex-Senator and (iv) regarding the representation of the Senate in Kashmir Committee of the National Assembly and to rename the same “Joint Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir.

2) Meeting held on 27-04-2017:

- i. Briefing on the budgetary allocations and its utilization for the financial year 2016-17 by the Ministry of Kashmir Affairs and Gilgit-Baltistan in terms of Rule 166 of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate and budget proposals for the year 2017-18.
- ii. Comprehensive implementation status of recommendations of the Committee meeting held on 15-3-2017 including chalk out details of all litigation matters in Pakistan on land/properties/buildings pertaining to Kashmir.

9. Important Recommendations of the Committee:

1) Meeting held on 15-03-2017:

- i. The Senate Standing Committee approved that comprehensive details of the property of Kashmir must be provided to the Committee
- ii. The Ambulance service system along three to four helicopters should be started for Gilgit-Baltistan.
- iii. The details of all the projects related to CPEC in Gilgit-Baltistan must be provided to the Committee.
- iv. Comprehensive details of all the medical facilities available in Gilgit-Baltistan may make available to the subsequent Committee meeting.
- v. The update and details about the request of Senator Muzamal Hussain Shah must be rendered in the next meeting.
- vi. The details of all correspondence on the issue of formulation of “Joint Committee of Parliament on Kashmir Affairs” essentially be presented in the upcoming meeting.

2) Meeting held on 24-04-2017:

- i. It was decided that by June end, comprehensive report on the petition of Senator Muzamal Shah will be submitted to the Committee.
- ii. The budget of AJK should be increased to meet the needs of the people so that it can be brought at par with rest of Pakistan.

Senate Standing Committee on Kashmir Affairs and Gilgit-Baltistan

- iii. The share of Royalty for AJK should be increased.
- iv. The government of Gilgit Baltistan should put more emphasis on power, transport and social sectors.
- v. The budget for development projects Gilgit Baltistan & Azad Jammu & Kashmir should be increased.
- vi. More focus should be given to the National Grid station of Gilgit Baltistan.
- vii. Tourism and mining sectors should be promoted at Gilgit Baltistan & Azad Jammu & Kashmir.
- viii. The youth of GB should be given soft loans of 5 to 7 lakh so that can build huts for promoting tourism and increasing the income of the people.
- ix. The property cases of the land/buildings pertaining to Kashmir should be actively pursued and complete information should be provided to the courts in order to assist the court to make early judgments as the delay is causing damage to the nation.
