












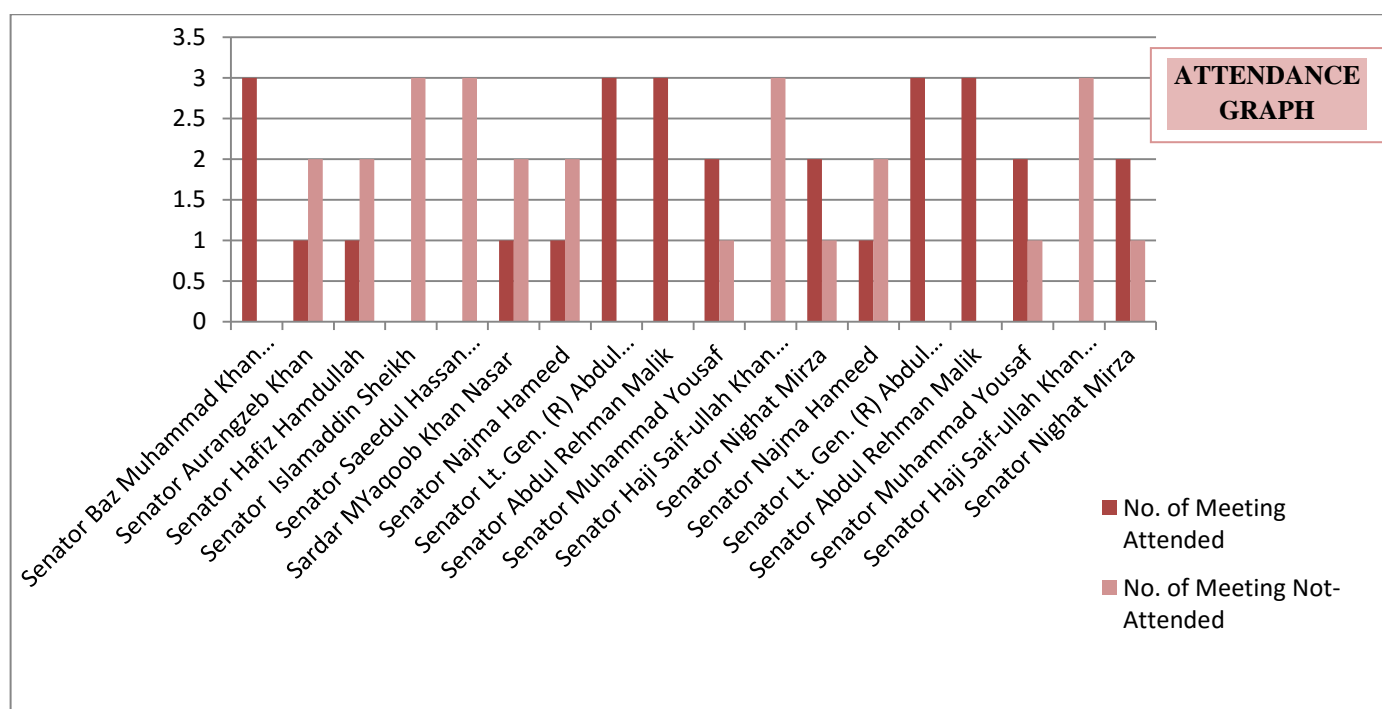

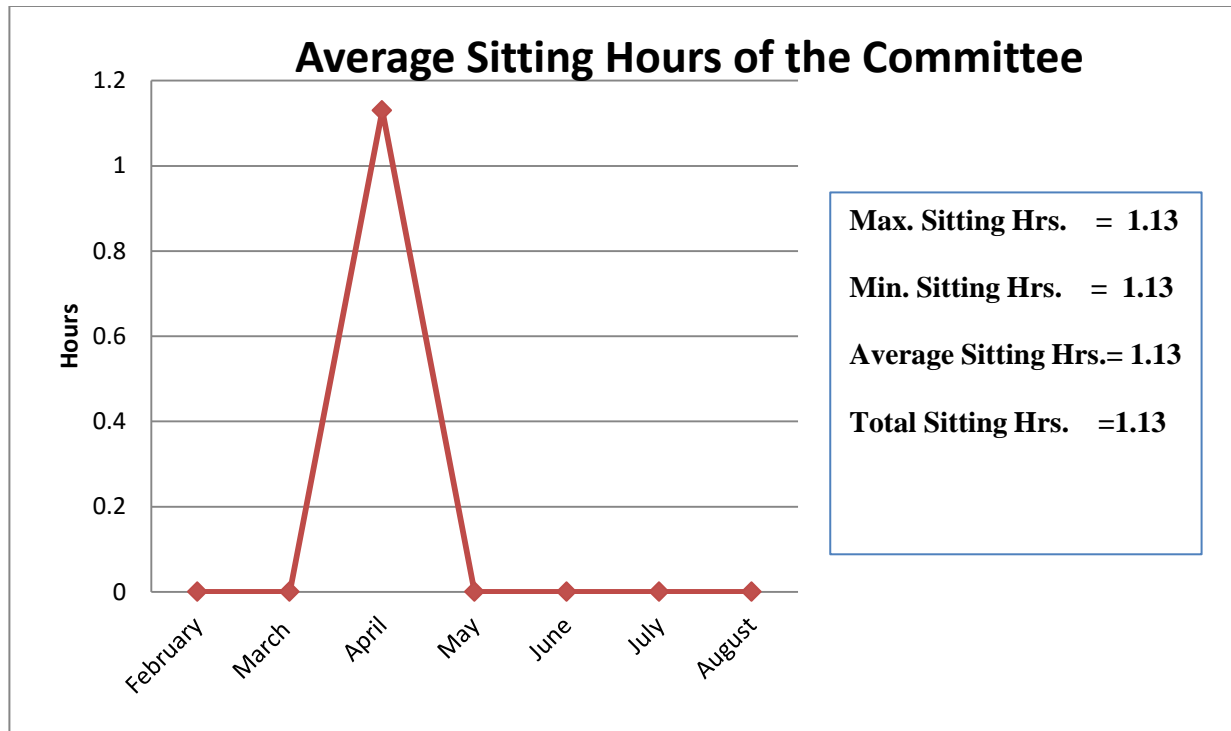

### **1) Meeting held on 19-04-2017:**

- i. Present status of construction of school buildings in Shahbaz Azmat Khel, Bannu, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and in Zhob, Balochistan.
- ii. Detail of employees of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Workers Welfare Board who are retained in service and who are removed from service and the criteria laid down for retention and removal of these employees.

## **9. Important Recommendations of the Committee:**

### **1) Meeting held on 19-04-2017:**

- i. Progress report on the construction of School buildings in Shahbaz Azmat Khail, Bannu and Zhob, Balochistan.
- ii. Progress report on hiring the rented buildings for schools and Polytechnic Institute for Girls at Zhob.
- iii. The issue of contract employees of Workers Welfare Board, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, may be resolved without further delay. The cases of contract employees who fulfill the prescribed criteria and those who do not fulfill the criteria need to be differentiated and final decision in this regard may be taken.
- iv. Ministry of Overseas Pakistanis and HRD should write a letter to the M/O Foreign Affairs to direct all Pakistani Embassies abroad that CWAs should send their report / input regarding demand of workers in various skills / professions and trades.
- v. OPF should evolve some strategy in collaboration with PIA regarding return of 6.2 Lacs Pakistanis workers from Saudi Arabia to facilitate them in the purchase of air tickets.
- vi. M.D., OPF, should submit report about the payment of Rs.50,000/- to the families of Pakistani workers stranded in Saudi Arabia. M/O Overseas Pakistanis and HRD should make efforts to capitalize the offer of 100,000 jobs by Qatar Government during the Foot Ball World Cup being held in Qatar.

### **2) Meeting held on 01-08-2017:**

- i. The projects of construction of School buildings, at Shahbaz Azmat Khail, Bannu and Zhob, Balochistan should be finalized in the next meeting of the General Body of WWF scheduled to be held on 16-08-2017.
- ii. Details about land purchased by Workers Welfare Board, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa during 2008-2013, its price, mode of payment, location and purpose may be provided to the Committee in its next meeting.

- iii. Responsibility should be fixed on recruitment of ineligible persons on contract basis by the WWB, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- iv. The issue of rationalization of contract employees of WWB, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with complete details may be placed before the meeting of the GB (WWF) scheduled for 16-08-2017.
- v. M/O Overseas Pakistanis and M/O Foreign Affairs may submit progress report / implementation status on the recommendations of the Sub-Committee of the Senate Standing Committee on Overseas Pakistanis & HRD which submitted its report/recommendations in the Senate on 08-06-2016 regarding problems faced by overseas Pakistanis.

**3) Meeting held on 22-08-2017:**

- i. The Committee expressed dissatisfaction on the absence of Secretary labour Department of Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from the meeting and decided that in future the Committee will take serious notice in this regard.
- ii. The Committee directed that Secretary, M/O Overseas Pakistanis and HRD should personally lookafter the project of building of Schools at Bannu and Zhob and the M/O Finance should be properly pursued for the release of funds.
- iii. There are five references by NAB against Workers Welfare Board, KPK. NAB officials may be called to give details about these references in the next meeting of the Committee.
- iv. The M/O Overseas Pakistanis and HRD should search for jobs in other countries apart from Middle East and Gulf Countries.
