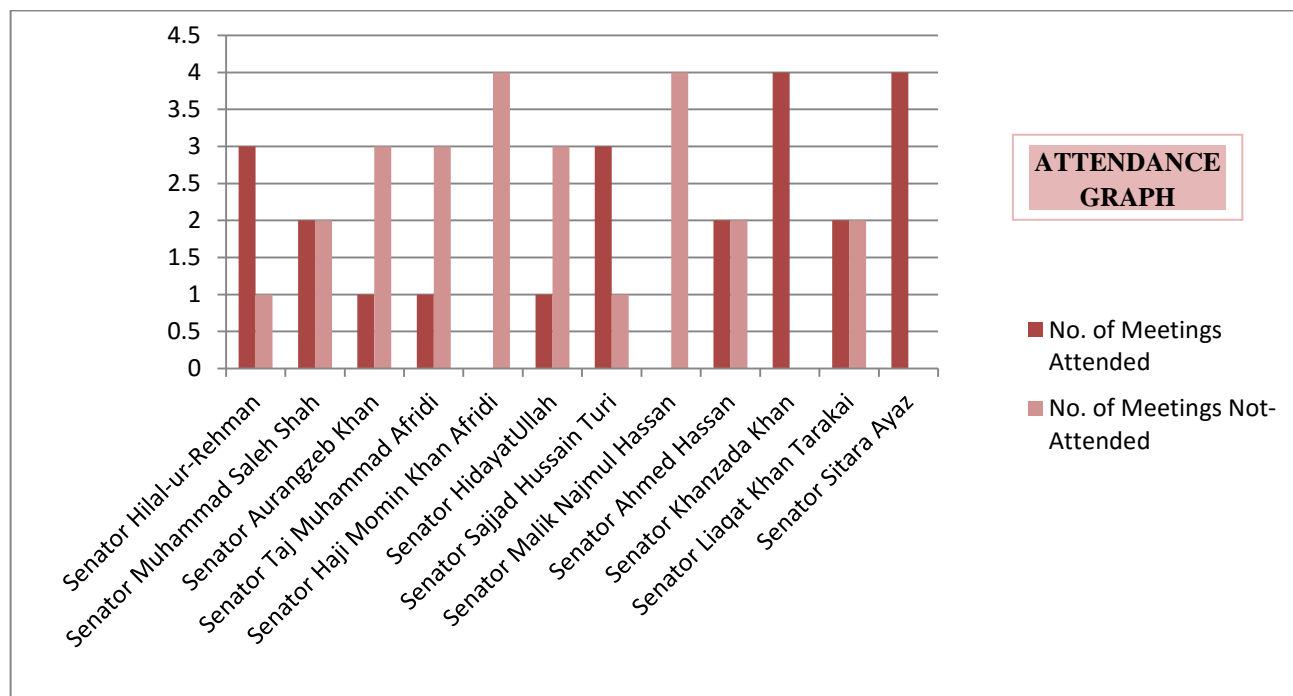

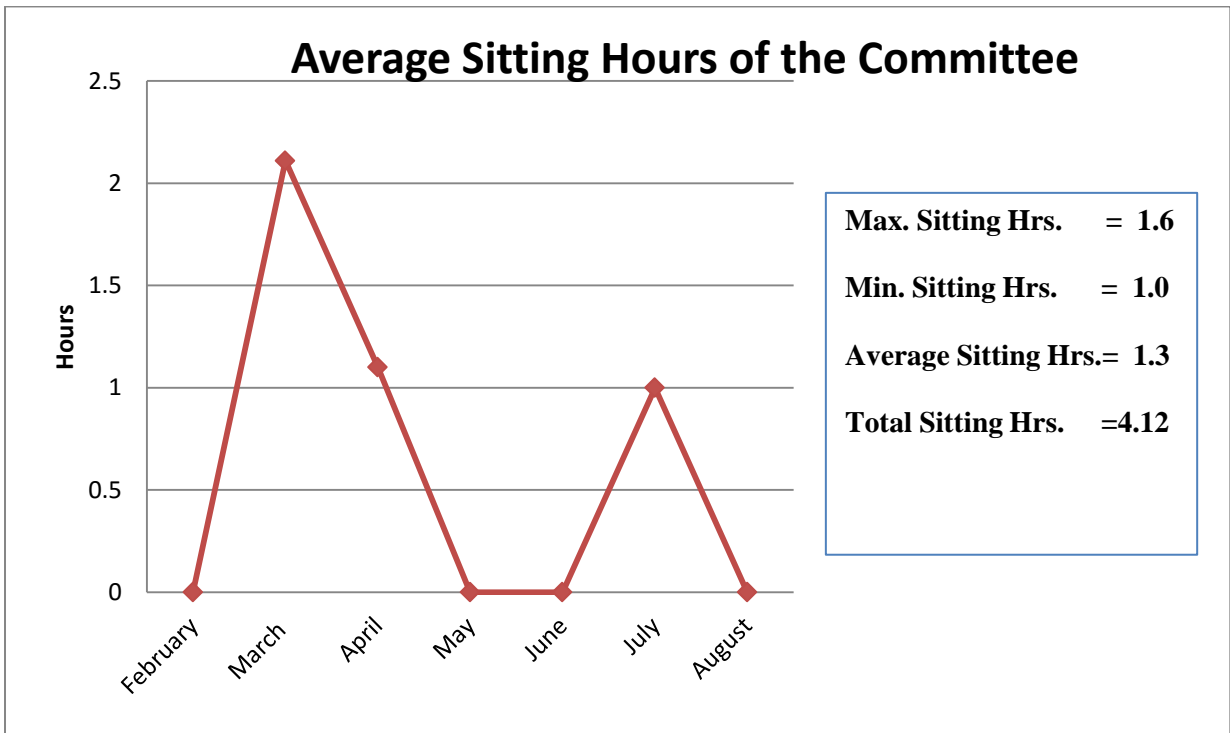

## **9. Important Recommendations of the Committee:**

### **1) Meeting held on 10-03-2017:**

- i. The contract employees of Afghan Refugees Organization (ARO), Health Staff, may be regularized.
- ii. Establishment of two degree colleges in Bajour Agency.

### **2) Meeting held on 30-03-2017:**

- i. Posts required for Cadet Colleges in FATA may be approved by the Finance Division.
- ii. The Ministry of States and Frontier Regions may take action for not filling the sanctioned posts by the FATA Secretariat.
- iii. FATA reforms should be implemented expeditiously by the M/O SAFRON.
- iv. Ministry of States and Frontier Regions may fix the responsibility on the delayed supply of books to the students in Government Schools in Mohmand Agency.
- v. The contract employees of Afghan Refugees Organization (ARO), Health staff, may be regularized.

### **3) Meeting held on 25-04-2017:**

- i. New Centre's of NADRA may be opened at Sub-Divisions level in FATA, alongwith provision of Mobile Vans.
- ii. MRVs may be provided in North Waziristan Agency on urgent basis.
- iii. In view of heavy rush of general public, the NADRA Centre's may be opened on Saturdays also.

**4) Meeting held on 13-07-2017:**

- i. In South Waziristan Agency, separate NADRA Centre's for male and female customers may be opened.
- ii. M/O Interior may take steps to post additional staff at NADRA Centre's at FATA and more Centres may be established to facilitate the general public at FATA.
- iii. Case of regularization of project staff of the Project Directorate of Health for Afghan Refugees may once again be sent to the Establishment Division and Finance Division for favorable action on humanitarian grounds.
- iv. Contract employees of the Health and Education Departments of FATA may be regularized.
- v. As recommended by the Senate Committee in its meeting held on 10-03-2017, the FATA Secretariat may constitute a Committee consisting of Secretary Social Sector, Political Agent Bajour Agency and a representative each of FC and M/O SAFRON to submit its report on the feasibility of acquiring free of cost land for the proposed two degree colleges at Bajaur Agency.

**5) Meeting held on 17-08-2017:**

- i. The Establishment Division informed that the Prime Minister has approved the appointment of Mian Asad Hayaud Din, as Chairman of the Committee for regularization of services of contract / Daily Wages and the pending cases will be placed before the Committee for consideration of their services for regularization as per policy guideline on merit. The Secretary Establishment Division assured the Committee that issue of regularization of Project staff of the Project Directorate of Health for Afghan Refugees will be considered by the Regularization Committee shortly.

**6) Meeting held on 18-08-2017:**

- i. The Committee recommended that maximum amount of recovery of funds made by NAB should be dispersed to the concerned agencies in FATA.
- ii. The Committee directed the FATA Secretariat to submit a report within 15 days on the background and current rules applied in FATA regarding less collection from mines and minerals.
