1.	Senator Osman Saifullah Khan (R.D.No.35)	"This House recommends that the Federal Government should introduce a voucher scheme to allow talented students from low income backgrounds to study at any private school in the Federal Capital."
2.	Senator Sehar Kamran (R.D.No. 40)	"This House strongly condemns the statement of the Indian Prime Minister, Narendra Modi attributing terrorism to Pakistan and drawing a parallel between India and Isreal evoking a parallel between Kashmir and Pakistan, during the recently held BRICS Summit held in Goa, India. The House appreciates the reaction of International Community to this baseless propaganda by the Indian Prime Minister.

The House believes that the statement made by the Indian Premier was an effort to divert the attention of the International Community from the Indian atrocities against the people of Indian Occupied Kashmir.

The House reiterates that there will be no compromise on the sovereignty and defence of Pakistan and our resolve to fight against terrorism and contribute towards bringing peace and harmony in the world."
