**PERIODICAL REPORTS BY THE MINISTERS ON THE  
RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE STANDING COMMITTEES**  
**(Under Rule 265A)**

**Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination** to report under rule 265A of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, on the following ten recommendations made by the Standing Committee concerned:-

- (i) Ministry of Inter-Provincial Coordination should ensure the payment of production bonus to Balochistan;
- (ii) Ministry of Inter-Provincial Coordination should take necessary steps for payment of pending liability of Federal Government on account of devolved Cadet Colleges to the Government of Balochistan;
- (iii) Ministry of Inter-Provincial Coordination should immediately convene a meeting of the Council of Common Interests (CCI) at the earliest;
- (iv) Ministry of Inter-Provincial Coordination should take necessary measures for transfer of Saindak project to Government of Balochistan;
- (v) Ministry of Water and Power should ensure double Circuit Dadu-Khuzdar and DG Khan-Loralai lines to achieve the target quantity of 725 MW;
- (vi) Funds allocation to Universities should not be made on basis of enrollment with special reference to Balochistan Province;
- (vii) The Sheikh Zayed Hospital, Quetta should be given fiscal and administrative power to run its affairs smoothly without interventions;
- (viii) The Sheikh Zayed Hospital, Quetta should be given PGMI status and arrangements should be made for functioning of Nursing School;
- (ix) Federal Government should make arrangements for releasing and arranging foreign aided programmes for the Sheikh Zayed Hospital, Quetta; and
- (x) Ministry of Inter-Provincial Coordination should take immediate steps to establish the permanent Secretariat of the Council of Common Interests (CCI) in terms of Article 154 (3) of the Constitution.

**Minister for National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination** to report under rule 265A of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, on the following four recommendations made by the Standing Committee concerned:-

- (i) PM&DC should ensure that at the time of constitution of various Committees as per provisions of the Ordinance, the existing Forensic faculties as well as all other concerned entities should be taken on board, especially;
  - (ii) Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination to ensure service structure revision / up-gradation of Pharmacists in public sector. Moreover the Ministry should ensure that Pharmacy Council of Pakistan may take adequate steps for service structure revision of Pharmacists in the private sector as well, both in the Federation and the Provinces;
  - (iii) Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination to finalize seniority lists / seniority rules of Medical Officers of Directorate of CHE, Islamabad within a period of one month and conduct meetings of DPC to consider promotions of eligible employees; and
  - (iv) Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination to strictly follow the rules while making acting/ current charge appointments against the vacant posts in the Directorate of CHE, Islamabad.
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
