5. **SENATOR MUHAMMAD TALHA MEHMOOD**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Cabinet Secretariat, to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the period for submission of report on the matter arising out of the starred question No. 114, asked by Senator Muhammad Azam Khan Swati, on 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2016, regarding the amount spent by ERRRA in AJK, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Batagram, Kohistan and other areas for rehabilitation and reconstruction in the wake of 2005 earthquake, which was referred by the House on 22<sup>nd</sup> January, 2016, may be extended for a period of forty-five working days with effect from 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2016, in order to enable the Committee to finalize its report.
