BILL TO BE INTRODUCED

2. **SENATOR SIRAJUL HAQ** to move for leave to introduce a Bill further to amend the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan [The Constitution (Amendment) Bill, 2016]. [Amendment of Articles 5 and 6]
