SENATOR MUHAMMAD JAVED ABBASI, Chairman, Standing Committee on Law and Justice to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the period for presentation of report of the Committee on the matter referred by the House on 14th June, 2016, regarding "recalling/withdrawal of Order by the Chairman National Accountability Bureau (NAB) wherein acting/current charges were given to various officers of NAB, in violation of rules, and reappointment of same officers, on the same day, in the Own Pay Scale (OPS)", may be extended for a further period of thirty working days with effect from 9th December, 2016.

9. SENATOR MUHAMMAD JAVED ABBASI, Chairman, Standing Committee on Law and Justice to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the period for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962, in its application to Islamabad Capital Territory, [The Civil Courts (Amendment) Bill, 2016], referred by the House on 7th October, 2016, may be extended for a period of ten working days with effect from 7th December, 2016.

AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE RULES

(Under Rule 278)

11. SENATORS RAJA MUHAMMAD ZAFAR-UL-HAQ, LEADER OF THE HOUSE AND AITZAZ AHSAN, LEADER OF THE OPPOSITION, to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 278 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, to move,-

(i) that in rule 172, the existing sub-rule (3) shall be re-numbered as sub-rule (5) and after the re-numbering, the following new sub-rules shall be inserted, namely:-

“(3) The Committee shall also act as ‘Committee on Ethics’ and review the Code of Conduct, from time to time and ensure that the Code is implemented.

(4) The Committee on Ethics shall provide for its rules of procedure.”

(ii) that after rule 226, the following new rule 226A shall be inserted, namely:-

“**226A. Code of Conduct for the members.-** There shall be a Code of Conduct for the members to assist them in the discharge of their duties and obligations to the House, their constituents and the public at large.”

13. SENATORS RAJA MUHAMMAD ZAFAR-UL-HAQ, LEADER OF THE HOUSE AND AITZAZ AHSAN, LEADER OF THE OPPOSITION, to move that the proposed amendments in rule 172 and insertion of new rule 226A in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, be adopted.
