
Subject:- MEETING OF THE SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE ON CABINET SECRETARIAT

2. The **revised agenda** before the Committee would be as under:-

- (i) Consideration of the subject matter of Starred Question No. 203, asked by Senator Muhammad Azam Khan Swati, regarding the "**details f cases and violation of CDA by-laws etc. by various shopping malls and hotels in Islamabad during the last two years including those committed by Safa Gold Mall and Grand Hayat**" referred by the House to the Committee on 17th March, 2017 for consideration and report.
- (ii) Consideration of a Private Member bill titled "**The Right to Free and Compulsory Education (Amendment) Bill, 2017**" moved by Senator Mian Muhammad Ateeq Shaikh in the Senate, referred by the House to the Committee on 13th March, 2017 for consideration and report.
- (iii) Consideration of the subject matter of Public Petition No. PP-1762 pertaining to exploitation of parents & students by private schools [preventive measures/steps taken by the concerned officers/agencies regarding use of drugs in the public/private educational institutions]
- (iv) Consideration of the subject matter of Public Petition No. PP-1774 pertaining to degradation of National sports heroes.
- (v) Briefing by the CDA regarding plantation of trees during the spring season, number of outdated trees surveyed, policy pertaining to pollen and termites hazardous trees.
- (vi) Detailed briefing by Pakistan Bait-ul-Mall on its projects / services meant for the deserving people especially one of its beneficial project i.e. Food Support Program in the past but it was closed and its 2.5 million beneficiaries were abandoned Reasons / justifications for its closure and the complete details of audit report relevant to that project.
- (vii) Detailed briefing on the sector-wise allocation of quota for provision of water supply to all the sectors of Islamabad including newly developed / under-developed sectors including sector D-12.
- (viii) Any other item with the permission of the Chair.
