REVISED NOTICE

The meeting of the Senate Committee on Delegated Legislation scheduled to be held on 2nd November, 2017, at 10:30 a.m. in Committee Room No. 4, Parliament House, Islamabad will now be held on the **same date and venue at 11:30 am.**

2. The agenda before the Committee would be as under:-
- i. Further discussion on the National School of Public Policy Rules 2017 framed under the NSPP Amendment Ordinance 2017 and recommend removal of anomalies, if any.
 - ii. Establishment Division to give the report pertaining to Rule 9 (ii) of CSS Rules, which bars disable persons from Opting Occupational Group according to their merit, hence it is ultra vires to the Constitution.
 - iii. Ministry of Finance, Revenue and Economic Affairs to brief on Rule 17 of the Behhood Savings Certificates Rules, 2003 and Rule 13 of Defence Saving Certificates Rules, 1966, in the light of judgment of the Lahore High Court in Regular First Appeals Nos. 152 and 159 of 2010.
 - iv. Ministry of Defence to apprise the Committee about appropriate legal instrument that was directed to be issued by the competent authority in the Federal Government, for setting out the essential details regarding rights, privileges and terms and conditions of service of the civilian employees working in the Directorate of Education of the Garrison and in the Defence Division and other attached departments thereto, vide judgment of the Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 654 of 2007 (PLD 2017 Supreme Court 173).
 - v. Ministry of Information, Broadcasting, National History and Literary Heritage to brief about Rules 13(3) & 13(4) of the PEMRA Rules, 2009 and Regulations 2.11 & 3.23 of the PEMRA (Eligibility Criteria and Bidding Procedure for Direct to Home (DTH) Distribution Service Licensing) Regulations, 2016, that were struck down vide judgment of the Lahore High Court in the writ petition No. 25317 of 2016 (PLD 2017 Lahore 289).
 - vi. Any other item with permission of the Chair.
