3. Admissibility of the following Adjournment Motions will be determined:-

- (i) **Adj. Motion No. 1(15-269/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Sherry Rehman to discuss the interim award issued by London Court of International Arbitration on 8th June, 2017 in favour of nine IPPs directing Pakistan to immediately pay 10.977 billion rupees and to further discuss the need of Parliamentary oversight in key international arbitration cases.
- (ii) **Adj. Motion No. 2(17-269/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Sehar Kamran to discuss the statement of Indian Air Force Chief made on 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2017, that Indian Air Force has the capability to strike nuclear sites in Pakistan and they are ready for a full spectrum operation.
- (iii) **Adj.
