

SENATE SECRETARIAT ORDERS OF THE DAY

for the meeting of the Senate to be held at 3:00 p.m. on Monday, the 11th December, 2017.

1. Recitation from the Holy Quran.

LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

2. **SENATOR SEHAR KAMRAN** to move that the Bill further to amend the Child Marriage Restraint Act, 1929 [The Child Marriage Restraint (Amendment) Bill, 2017], as reported by the Standing Committee, be taken into consideration, at once.

3. **SENATOR SEHAR KAMRAN** to move that the Bill further to amend the Child Marriage Restraint Act, 1929 [The Child Marriage Restraint (Amendment) Bill, 2017] be passed.

DEFERRED MOTIONS

[Under Rule 218]

4. **SENATOR MOHSIN AZIZ** to move that this House may discuss the issue of Industrial sector's becoming unviable and uncompetitive in international market due to which the country is becoming a trading rather than a producing country.
5. **SENATOR MOHSIN AZIZ** to move that the House may discuss the matters relating to upcoming and recently established IPPs in the country with particular reference to wind and solar plants, their cost and the tariff determined for the electricity being produced by those plants and its negative effects on common people, exports and industrial production.
6. **SENATOR MUHAMMAD TALHA MAHMOOD** to move that the House may discuss the overall performance of National Highway Authority with particular reference to its ongoing projects of Motorways and National Highways in the country.

MOTIONS

7. **SENATOR MUHAMMAD TALHA MAHMOOD** to move that the House may discuss the Foreign Policy of the Government.
8. **SENATOR MUHAMMAD JAVED ABBASI** to move that the House may discuss the Government policy for allotment of plots to the Federal Government officers in BPS-21 and 22, Judges, lawyers and journalists without any balloting while depriving the large number of deserving employees of lower scales.
9. **SENATOR FARHATULLAH BABAR** to move that this House may discuss the situation arising out of the recent dharna at Faizabad, Islamabad, the space given by the Government to the protesters, its implications for the state and society and the way forward.

10. SENATOR SEHAR KAMRAN to move that the House may discuss the role of CCI in promoting harmony and building confidence between federation and federating units in the country.

11. SENATOR SITARA AYAZ to move that this House may discuss the matter of missing of 12.5 million women of 18 years and above from the voters lists as pointed out by the Election Commission of Pakistan.

DEFERRED RESOLUTIONS

12. SENATOR SEHAR KAMRAN to move the following resolution:-

"The House recommends that the Government should lay all international conventions, treaties, covenants, commitments and agreements signed or ratified by the Government of Pakistan before both Houses of Parliament."

13. SENATOR MUHAMMAD TALHA MAHMOOD to move the following resolution:-

"The House recommends that the Government should take necessary steps to control the lowering of Water Table in the country."

14. SENATOR KARIM AHMED KHAWAJA to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government should facilitate all those persons who left Pakistan at the time of partition or after that, and settled in other countries, in case they want to visit their motherland for religious or tourism purposes or they want to make investment or engage in some trade and business in the country."

RESOLUTIONS

15. SENATOR SEHAR KAMRAN to move the following resolution:-

"The House remember and pay tribute to the martyrs of the Army Public School, Peshawar, on the third anniversary of the deadliest terrorist attack in Pakistan's history, which claimed the lives of more than 140 people, mostly children. The supreme sacrifices rendered by children and teachers on 16th December, 2014 cannot go in vain, and we as a nation must stand together to eliminate the scourge of terrorism and violent extremism from our soil once and for all."

16. SENATOR MOHSIN AZIZ to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government may investigate all business houses and persons whose names appeared in Panama Paper leaks during the year 2016."

17. SENATOR COL. (R) SYED TAHIR HUSSAIN MASHHADI to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government should take necessary steps to introduce unified pay scales for all Federal Government employees including those working in corporations, institutions and entities being paid from the Federal Government Funds."

18. SENATOR SHERRY REHMAN to move the following resolution:-

"Following the Kathmandu Declaration for the rights of South Asian Home Based Workers (HBWs);

Recognizing them as laborers, as ILO Convention C177 which highlights the rights of HBWs;

This House recommends that the Government should conduct a census of home-based workers and map them according to the task they perform."

19. SENATOR DR. JEHANZEB JAMALDINI to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that the Government should make a policy for provision of Jammers for private vehicles to high profile figures like, Members of the National Assembly, Senate and Provincial Assemblies, Heads of Political Parties, Ex-Chief Ministers and Governors owing to security reasons."
