### **CONSIDERATION OF ADMISSIBILITY OF ADJOURNMENT MOTIONS**

3. Admissibility of the following Adjournment Motions will be determined:-

Motion No. 1(1-271/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Maulana Hafiz Hamdullah to discuss various mental and Physical issues being faced by the children under fourteen years of age in Pakistan which are 35.5 % of total population as per recent census. Moreover, as per the National Management Information System, which is a subsidiary of the Ministry of Education, 22.6 % children are out of schools.

Motion No. 2(2 and 5-271/2017-M)**, separate notices given of by Senators Farhatullah Babar, Saeedul Hassan Mandokhail and Sehar Kamran to discuss the situation arising out of the manner in which the recent sit-in at Faizabad was called off culminating into abject surrender of the rule of law and constitutionally established Government before a stick and gun wielding mob. **Clubbed**
- (iii) **Adj. Motion No. 3(3-271/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Mohsin Aziz to discuss the planning of the Government of Pakistan to repay the interest and principal amount of the huge loans in the Financial Year 2018-2019 with the present balance of trade and account deficit.
