### **CONSIDERATION OF ADMISSIBILITY OF ADJOURNMENT MOTIONS**

3. Admissibility of the following Adjournment Motions will be determined:-

- (i) **Adj. Motion No. 1(14-271/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Mohsin Aziz to discuss the devastating effect of the recent devaluation of Pak Rupee by over 10 percent which will further burden the already crippled economy.
- (ii) **Adj. Motion No. 2(16-271/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Mukhtiar Ahmed Dhamrah @ Aajiz to discuss the preparation of the Government towards the making of budget for the Financial Year 2018-19.
- (iii) **Adj. Motion No. 3(17-271/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Sherry Rehman to discuss the swelling of Pakistan's trade deficit to 15 billion USD in just five months which is eating up the foreign exchange reserves.

SENATOR ABDUL REHMAN MALIK**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the subject matter of starred question No. 90, asked by Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati on 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2017, regarding the sub-standard print and ink being used on the front page of official passports, may be extended for a period of thirty working days with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> December, 2017.

**5. SENATOR ABDUL REHMAN MALIK**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report on a matter raised by Senator Maulana Hafiz Hamdullah on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, regarding "Gharang Check Post of FC in Balochistan due to which long queues of vehicles is a daily routine causing great problems to the people of the areas", may be extended for a further period of thirty working days with effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2018.

SENATOR ABDUL REHMAN MALIK**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on a matter of grievances of media persons regarding attack on Mr. Ahmed Norani, raised in the House on 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2017, and the issue of other journalists raised in the House on 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2017, regarding the progress report of pending inquiries / investigations of their cases, may be extended for a period of thirty working days with effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2018.

SENATOR ABDUL REHMAN MALIK**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860, and the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 [The Criminal Laws (Amendment) (Protection of Rights of Transgender Persons) Bill, 2017], introduced by Senator Rubina Khalid, on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2017, may be extended for a further period of thirty working days with effect from 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2018.

**8. SENATOR ABDUL REHMAN MALIK**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill to provide for remedy and payment of compensation to those who are convicted as a result of miscarriage of justice [The Miscarriage of Justice (Compensation) Bill, 2017], introduced by Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati, on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2017, may be extended for a further period of thirty working days with effect from 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2018.
