Further consideration of the subject matter of Calling Attention Notice moved by Senator Hidayat Ullah regarding pending approval of 7500 sanctioned new posts (SNEs) for FATA which have already been approved by the FATA Secretariat and the M/o SAFRON and referred to the Committee for consideration and report;

[Note: The report of the Committee is required to be presented to the House i.e. on or before 25th February, 2018]
- (iv). Scrutiny of the Public Sector Development Program (PSDP) proposed by the M/o Finance for the next financial year and to suggest amendments, if necessary, and make recommendations thereon for inclusion in the Federal Budget for the next financial year, as required under Rule (166) (7) of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate 2012;
- (v). Discussion with the FBR with respect to tax exemption on the import of micro feeder equipment used for food fortification;
- (vi). Briefing by the FBR on amending the SRO 502(I)/2004, dated 12th June, 2004, being a valid notification for the tribal areas under Central Excise Act, 1944, to the extent of FATA. (For clarification, it is stated that Federal Excise Act, 2005 didn't repeal Central Excise Act, 1944 to the extent of PATA), as recommended by the Standing Committee in the recommendations of Finance Bill, 2017, and dropped in the House erroneously;
- (vii). Progress report by the Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP) on the conversion of manual payment mechanism to Biometric Verification System (BVS) to the BISP beneficiaries;
