- 5. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs while presenting the review of budget allocation and its utilization by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs during first six months of Financial Year 2017-18 in terms of sub-rule (4) of Rule 166 of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in



the Senate, 2012 stated that there are three demands under the budget heads for non-development expenditure allocated to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs under grants numbers 45, 46 and 47.

Demand No. 45 - Headquarters

Demand No. 45 caters for the expenditure relating to headquarters. Funds to the tune of Rs. 1.404,956 million were allocated in Demand No. 45 for the current financial year i.e. 2017-18. In the month of November, 2017 funds to the tune of Rs. 23,165,000 million were provided through Supplementary Grant to cater for additional requirements due to payment to be made for Prime Minister Assistance Package for Families of Deceased Employees and to operationalize new heads of account. Total final budget is Rs. 1,428,121,000 million. Funds amounting to Rs. 675,.235,000 million have been consumed till 31.12.2017. The total percentage of expenditure on final grant is Rs. 47.28%. The reason for excess expenditure is as under:-

- The Basic Pay Scale have been revised, Adhoc Relief Allowance for the year 2010 has been merged and Adhoc Relief Allowance 2017 has also been allowed @ 10% in pay of officers/officials.
- Payment to the families of employees who died during service.

Demand No. 46 - Pak Missions Abroad

Funds to the tune of Rs. 12,764,246 million were allocated in Demand No. 46 for the current financial year i.e. 2017-18. Funds to the tune of Rs. 650,442 million were provided through Supplementary Grant to cater for additional requirements. Total final budget is Rs. 13,414,688 million. Funds amounting to Rs. 5,715,242 million have been consumed till 30.11.2017. The total percentage of expenditure on final grant is 42.60%. The reasons for provision of supplementary grants are as under:-

- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 21.200 million for hiring of Center for Strategic & International Studies to Project Pakistan's soft image in United States (Parep Washington)
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 21.000 million in respect of Parep Riyadh for purchase of vehicles.
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 200.000 million in respect of Parep Doha and London for miscellaneous expenditure including legal charges.
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 407.975 for opening of new wings in respect of other Ministries.
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 0.067 million for operating of new heads of account in Parep Melbourne's budget.



Demand No. 47 - Other Expenditure of Foreign Affairs Division

Funds to the tune of Rs. 2,386,241 million were allocated in the budget for Demand No. 47 for the current financial year i.e. 2017-18. Fund to the tune of Rs. 716,903 million were provided through Supplementary Grant to cater for additional requirements. Total final budget is Rs. 3,103,144 million. Funds amounting to Rs. 1,591,003 million have been consumed till 31.12.2017. The total percentage of expenditure on final grant is 51.27%.

- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 10.700 million for Establishment of Public Diplomacy Fund at Pahic London.
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 107.000 million for Relief Assistance for flood affected people of Nepal.
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 535.000 million for Contribution of Govt. of Maldives for construction of a Hospital.
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 64.200 million as Financial Assistance to Antigua & Barbuda, Dominica and St. Kitts and Nevis in the aftermath of the Hurricane Destruction in the area.
- Supplementary Grant of Rs. 0.003 million for operating in new heads of account.
