- 4. The representative, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination gave a detailed presentation to the Committee on the current level of WHO Certification to DRAP. He informed that for seeking the said certification, at present, level 2 of the procedure had been achieved while, as per the initiatives, taken by DRAP in Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination, 68% progress had also been made to achieve level 3. Furthermore, the CEO, DRAP explain all the steps of WHO registration levels and assure the Committee that within six months level 3 will be achieved and next level working will be start. Senator Dilawar Khan was of the view that in the absence of WHO certification, the local industry was unable to export drugs to the international market. The Committee showed it's grieved concern as a matter of fact that export of all types of medicines is decreasing day by day. Necessary steps should be taken by the DRAP and Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination.
- The Committee decided to visit National Control Laboratory (NCL), Islamabad and discuss about WHO level 3. DRAP also get report and take NCL on board to speed up the certification process of WHO.
- 6. After detailed deliberation, the Committee disposed of the matter with the direction that the MS wing to issue NOC for finalizing the recruitment process against HR positions in order to meet the requirements of WHO level 3.
