
NOTICE

A meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Power will be held on 23rd July, 2019 (Tuesday) at 02:30 p.m. in Committee Room No.4, Parliament House, Islamabad. **(In case of the Senate Session in the evening, the meeting will be held at 11:30 a.m.)**

2. The agenda of the meeting would be as follows:-

- i. Briefing on the installed and peak season generation of hydroelectricity along with details of all Power Stations in the country.
- ii. Briefing on the overbilling and unscheduled load shedding by the K-Electric as reported in the print and electronic media.
- iii. Briefing on the following matters related to the PESCO:-
 - a) Steps taken during the last one year to curtail line losses and theft with the outcome thereof;
 - b) Camp-wise position of the electricity supply, bill collection and steps taken to clear the arrears, if any, during the last five years, from all the Afghan Refugees Camps in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa alongwith the details of the action taken against the people, including the refugees, allegedly involved in the theft of electricity and caused financial loss to the PESCO.
 - c) Updated position of the inquiry into the case of recovery of 600/650 stolen transformers of PESCO by FIA from a private store in the year 2012/13.
- iv. Briefing on the demand and supply position of the TESCO and QUESCO, feeder-wise line losses/theft, steps taken to improve the situation with result thereof, debt position of the respective DISCO and the way forward to clear it.
- v. Progress report on the actions taken by the Power Division and all concerned in the light of the report of the Sub-Committee of the SSC on Power in which 17 recommendations were made to curb the menace of electricity theft, curtailment of line losses and streamlining of the overall working and performance of DISCOs. *(The report was presented in the meeting of the Standing Committee on Power on 02-10-2018. The Committee adopted the report and recommended to send the same to the Power Division for further necessary action).*
- vi. Any other item with permission of the Chair.
