3. The Committee considered the Point of Public Importance in its meeting held on 2nd December, 2019 at Committee Room No.1, Parliament House, Islamabad. Meeting was attended by the following Members:-

4. The Committee had detailed discussion on the agenda Senator Muhammad Ali Khan Saif briefly explained the examination system of Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan. He pointed out the lacunae in prevailing system especially with reference to the petition raised by Mr Fahad Haneef. Regarding discriminatory examination system of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan, the Committee heard the petitioner regarding the injustice in professional CA qualification as well as the Vice President of the



Institute of Chartered Accountants views about the merits and criteria of this field of education. Rana Usman Khan, Vice President Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan (ICAP) told the committee that Mr. Farhad Hanif was debarred from attempting his last paper of "Cost and Management Accounting" after availing eight permissible attempts under the directive of the Council of ICAP. Committee agreed that no more chance can be given to the student.

5. At the end of the meeting, the Committee members suggested that if a student fails in all of his attempts to clear the examination, he must be given a chance to begin all over again as is the precedence in all of the foreign countries. There should be no age bar to pursue the Charted Accountancy degree. All the students must be explicitly told about the rules, regulations and examination system pertaining to the degree repeatedly, especially in the beginning of their every academic session.
