**MOTION**

**[Under Rule 194(1)]**

**Senator Hidayat Ullah**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Communications, moved under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Standing Committee on the subject matter of supplementary question, asked by Senator Nauman Wazir Khattak to Starred Question No. 130, regarding Sukkur-Multan (M-5) Motorway, may be extended for a further period of thirty working days with effect from 12<sup>th</sup> November, 2018.

**The motion was put to the House and the required extension was granted.**
