REPORT OF THE SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE ON POWER ON POINT OF PUBLIC IMPORTANCE RAISED BY SENATOR SITARA AYAZ REGARDING THE ISSUE OF POWER SHUTDOWNS IN THE GADOON INDUSTRIAL AREA.

I, Senator Fida Muhammad, Chairman, Standing Committee on Power, have the honour to present, on behalf of the Committee, this report on Point of Public Importance raised by Senator Sitara Ayaz in the House on 14th January, 2020 regarding "scheduled power shutdowns in the Gadoon Industrial Area for the last three months".

3. The Committee considered the subject matter in its meeting held on 17th February, 2020, at Parliament House, Islamabad. The following attended the meeting:-

Mr. Muhammad Jabbar Khan, Chief Engineer (PMO), PESCO, while briefing the Committee on the agenda item said that due to the developmental work and system up-gradation, power supply in the Gadoon Industrial Area had remained shut down for 08 hours on every Sunday during the last three months. He told the Committee that the work had been completed and there would be no power shutdowns on that account. The Mover, Senator Sitara Ayaz, deplored the power shutdowns in the said area by PESCO on every Sunday for the last three months due to which common people had to suffer a lot. She suggested that while carrying out up-gradation work some alternate measures should be taken so that locals of the area might not be affected. She, however, expressed satisfaction that the work had been completed and in future there would be no more power shutdowns in the area. Senator Nauman Wazir Khattak suggested

that whenever developmental works were required to be done, emphasis should be to reduce the duration of the power shut down as much as it could be. The agenda item was accordingly disposed of.
