- vii) Consideration of petition of Dr. Fiaz Ahmed Chaudhry, Ex-Md, NTDC, addressed to the Chairman and Members of the Standing Committee on Power, regarding his alleged defamation by the NTDC and Power Division during meeting of the sub-Committee of the Standing Committee on Power held on 27-03-2019 under the Convener-ship of Senator Agha Shahzaib Durrani, as reported in the newspaper "Business Recorder" dated 28-03-2019.
