SUMMARY

The Ministry briefed that significant progress has been made to improve immunization coverage all over the country. Special outreach programmes were initiated in December, 2018 to reach the defaulters and un-immunized children. It provided multiple antigens to the community and covered 2609217 children in Sindh, Baluchistan, KPK and Islamabad.

Maintaining the cold chain for fool proof preservation of vaccine is all the more important. It was ensured that the cold chain capacity is enhanced and optimized. Strengthening of cold chain capacity at National, Provincial, District and UC level through implementation of Cold Chain Equipment Optimization Platform (CCECP) is always the goad. 6,782 CCE have been deployed in the country whereas, 8,2018 will be deployed by 2021.

Efforts were made to keep up an uninterrupted supply chain of vaccine and logistics at all levels. Cognizant of the human resource problems it was ensured that immunization service delivery has improved. Recruitment of more than 500 Vaccinators has been made in Sindh, around 340 new vaccinators in Baluchistan, 1800 new vaccinators in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for improvement of immunization service delivery.

Research and data go hand in hand for better implementation of health programmes. Data and research help in identification of gaps. For this purpose data quality

assessments are conducted throughout the country to improve the data quality. EPI Management Information System has been developed. It is being rolled out to all Provinces for generation of timely and complete data reports across the country. It also serves as data repository. Comprehensive EPI Reviews are being carried out in the country to assess the performance of the Programme, identify gaps and suggest way forward to bridge the gaps.

Training is an important component in implementation of the immunization programme. Training programmes are conducted periodically at all levels so that every nook and corner of the country is in loop of the recent research produced at national and international levels.

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee felt satisfied and recommended to further strengthen the research departments of the health care. The Committee endorsed all the programmes of the Ministry and decided to submit the report to the House.
