

REVISED NOTICE

Reference this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 29th January, 2021. Meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Power will be held on Monday, the 8th February, 2021, at 02: 00 p.m. in Committee Room No.4, Parliament House, Islamabad.

2. **Revised agenda** of the meeting will be as under:-
- i) Further consideration of Starred Question No. 15, asked by Senator Bahramand Khan Tangi, during the Senate Session held on 22nd October, 2020, regarding "the number of electricity meters installed by PESCO during the last six months with sub-division/area wise break up and the steps taken by the said company to control electricity theft through *kunda* system during the said period".
 - ii) Further consideration of Point of Public Importance regarding "non-installation of electricity meters, promotion of *kunda* culture and wrong billing by PESCO in district Charsadda" raised by Senator Bahramand Khan Tangi, during the Senate sitting held on 22nd January, 2021.
 - iii) Further consideration of Point of Public Importance regarding "provision of electricity to Makran Division through establishment of power projects in the area" raised by Senator Kauda Babar during the Senate sitting held on 22nd January, 2021.
 - iv) Briefing by the CEO, TESCO, on the utilization of funds allocated by the previous government through SDGs for electrification of villages in various erstwhile tribal districts during the last five years along with reasons for not carrying out the work despite the fact that funds were released and material was procured.
 - v) Comprehensive briefing by PESCO on the irregularities committed in the recruitment process of LS-II, Meter Readers, ALMs and Bill Distributors as pointed out by the Inquiry Committee of PEPCO along with details of the following:-
 - a) Reasons for non-inclusion of recruitment of SDOs/ROs in the TORs of the Inquiry Committee of PEPCO despite the fact that their tests were conducted by the same testing agency and interview/selection by the same management.
 - b) Actions taken against the PESCO management of the time and the testing agency.
 - c) The way forward.
 - vi) Any other item with permission of the Chair.
