

Major Issues taken up by the Committee:



Inadequate coverage of Senate Sessions on PTV Parliament

Recommended that proceedings of the Senate session and Committee meetings should be given adequate coverage on PTVC as matters of national importance are discussed there



Airing of indecent content on the PM

Expressed displeasure over airing of indecent content and defamatory attacks on Prime Minister and directed to ensure that such content may not be allowed to be telecasted in future




Payment of advertisement dues to the media outlets

Directed to ensure that all outstanding advertisement dues of the media outlets are duly paid and other issues related to PBA and APNS are also addressed



Delay in payments of salaries to media workers

Directed to ensure that the process of payments of arrears to the media workers is timely completed



Establishment of Pakistan's own web portal for local dramas and films

Recommended that DEMP should lead to establish a government administered web portal for airing of quality content for masses such as Netflix and Amazon Prime



Programming and Content on Radio Pakistan

Recommended that quality of production may be improved and special emphasizes should be given to diction and pronunciation of voice artists:

Directed that recitation of Holy Quran with translation in regional languages may be aired





Awareness Campaigns on Electronic Media

Directed that awareness campaigns against social evils and crimes such as child abuse and harassment of women should be aired in local and national languages



Programming and Content on PTV Sports

Directed that quality of production and content of programmes on PTV Sports should be improved and special focus be given on promos, montage and sports clips.



Equal Representation of Provinces on PTV

Directed the PTV to ensure that all provinces and their languages, cultures and political leadership are equally represented



Termination of services of contractual employees of Pakistan **Broadcasting Corporation (PBC)**

Recommended to revisit the decision of terminating contractual employees of PBC and further recommended that they may be reinstated on pure merit grounds.



Payment of honorarium to employees

Directed the Ministry to coordinate with the Ministry of Finance for making arrangements to pay honorarium to the employees of APP, PTV and PBC who worked beyond office hours for the budget sessions of the Parliament



Payment of Pensions

Ensured that pensions are duly paid to the retired employees of Information & Division Broadcasting and allied departments.


Programming and Content on PTV Global, PTV Home & PTV News

Film Policy

Handed over a comprehensive and precise film policy to the Division after consulting with the relevant stake holders for revival of cinema in Pakistan



Equal Representation of Political Parties

Directed the PTV to ensure equal representation of political parties on current affairs programme



Lok Virsa

Directed Lok Virsa to initiate awareness campaigns for preservation of national, cultural heritage and collaborate with PTV for live marathons and special occasions universities for research and festivals.
