3. The Committee considered the budgetary allocation and its utilization for the first half of financial year 2021-22, in respect of the Ministry of Maritime Affairs and its attached departments in its meeting held on 16th February, 2022. The meeting of the Committee was attended by the following members:-

4. The Committee was informed that there were 15 approved PSDP funded projects of the Ministry, and total allocation was Rs. 25.4 billion for the financial year 2021-22. The complete detail of PSDP funded projects is at Annex-A. Chairman Gwadar Port Authority (GPA) informed the Committee that Marine Services Vessel for Gwadar Port had been acquired and was on way to Pakistan from China, construction of Eastbay Expressway was 95% complete, Pak-China Technical & Vocational Institute had been completed and short courses would be offered soon.



The Committee was informed that a CPEC Support Unit was being established at Gwadar to facilitate delegations, who visit Gwadar for projects and activities in GPA.

- 5. The Secretary, Maritime Affairs informed the Committee that funds had been released for 1.2 MGD Reverse Osmosis Desalination (ROD) Plant at Gwadar and efforts were being made to complete the project by July, 2022.
- 6. The Committee was informed that Korangi Fishries Harbour Authority had hired a consultant for the feasibility study of three projects namely "Establishment of Business Park at Korangi Fish Harbour", "Establishment of Cold Storage and Freezing Tunnels" and "Modification of Auction Hall". It was informed that Finance Division has not disbursed the allocated funds for these projects.
- 7. The Committee was further informed that total budget allocation of the Ministry of Maritime Affairs for the financial year 2021-22 was Rs.1190 million. The budget allocated to different departments and expenditure made upto 31st December, 2021 was as under:-
