ACT No. VIII of 2013

An Act further to amend the Maritime Security Agency Act, 1994

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Maritime Security Agency Act, 1994 (X of 1994), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:--

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Maritime Security Agency (Amendment) Act, 2013.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

- 2. Amendment of long title, Act X of 1994.—In the Maritime Security Agency Act, 1994 (X of 1994), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in the long title, after the word "the", the word "Pakistan" shall be inserted.
- 3. Amendment of Preamble, Act X of 1994.—In the said Act, in the preamble, after the word "a", the word "Pakistan" shall be inserted.
- 4. Amerdment of section 1, Act X of 1994.—In the said Act, in section 1, in sub-section (2),—
 - (a) after the word "the", the word "Pakistan" shall be inserted; and
 - (b) after the word "the", occurring for the second time, the word "Pakistan" shall be inserted.
- 5. Amendment of section 2, Act X of 1994.—In the said Act, in section 2,—
 - (a) in clause (a), after the word "the", the word "Pakistan" shall be inserted; and
 - (b) in clause (c), the words "Maritime Security" shall be omitted.
- 6. Amendment of section 3, Act X of 1994.—In the said Act, in section 3, in sub-section (1), for the word "Maritime", the words "Pakistan Maritime" shall be substituted
- 7. Amendment of Schedule, Act X of 1994.—In the said Act, in the Schedule, for the word "Maritime", the words "Pakistan Maritime" shall be substituted.
