The following Act of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) received the assent of the President on the 11th October, 1994 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. XVIII of 1994

An Act further to amend the Sale of Goods Act, 1930

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Sale of Goods Act, 1930 (III of 1930), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Sale of Goods (Amendment) Act, 1994.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

- 2. Insertion of new section 16A, Act III of 1930. In the Sale of Goods Act. 1930 (III of 1930), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, after section 16, the following new section shall be inserted, namely:-
 - "16A. Seller to inform buyer of defect in goods sold.-Notwithstanding anything contained in section 16, and save where the parties have entered into an agreement to the contrary, the seller shall be under an obligation to inform the buyer of any defect in the goods sold at the time of the contract, except in a case where the defect is obviously known to the buyer.".
- 3. Amendment of section 37, Act III of 1930. In the said Act, in section 37, in sub-section (2), after the word "or", the commas and words ", if the goods delivered are such that it is difficult or time consuming to separate the quantity contracted for," shall be inserted.
