

4. The Committee held discussion on Question No.96 asked by Senator Sardar Muhammad Shafiq Tareen in the Senate sitting held on 11th February. Senator Muhammad Shafiq Tareen informed the Committee that there is 6% employment quota of Balochistan in the State Bank of Pakistan. However, currently, only 42 employees' from Balochistan are employed in SBP, which constitutes to about 4.5% of the total employment, below the sanctioned quota. He stressed upon that Balochistan quota should be ensured in letter and spirit as well as opportunities should be given at executive level to employees from Balochistan.

- 5. The Minister of State for Finance moreover said that directives would be issued to the State Bank of Pakistan to look into this issue. The Committee recommended that through the Young Professionals Induction Program, direct recruitment, and other opportunities, the State Bank should ensure that the quota for Balochistan is implemented and there should be a thorough verification of domiciles from Balochistan to ensure that only natives are employed.
- 6. The Committee also directed the State Bank of Pakistan to share the contact information of their Human Resource Department Head with Senator Muhammad Shafiq Tareen to coordinate and follow-up on this matter.
