3. The Standing Committee on Housing & Works considered the matter in its meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2023 under the Chairmanship of Senator Haji Hidayatullah. Khan. Following hon'ble Senators were present at the time of consideration of the Question:-

- 4. The Committee had invited and heard all stakeholders including, Senator Dost-Muhammad, the mover of the starred Question, officials and representatives from the Ministry of Housing and Works and representatives of Federal Government Employees Housing Authority (FGEHA) and Pak PWD.
- The Committee thereafter deliberated upon the starred question raised by Senator Dost 5. Muhammad. Thereafter, Senator Dost Muhammad explained the deplorable condition of the government housing Colony in Sector G-8, Islamabad. He said that the government had not issued any fund for the maintenance and development of the houses from A to E type, allotted to the Federal Government Employees. However, the funds have always been allocated to the houses possessed by deputy, joint, additional and federal secretaries. He enquired the Ministry about the funds reserved for the government houses with special emphasis on the Colony in Sector G-8. The Director General (FGEHA), informed the Committee that the Federal Government had issued Rs. 40 Million for the Federal Government Houses, which is not sufficient for their maintenance. It was further informed that the maintenance work has been started on the Category-6 and 5 Flats in Sectors G-9, G-10 and I-9 areas from the allocation of funds worth, Rs. 100 million approved in PSDP. In response of the brief, the mover asked about the flats in Sector G-6, to which it was replied that the CDA, deals with the same. Moreover, Rs.716 million have further been demanded from the government for maintenance of the houses, to which no response has been received yet. The Secretary Housing and Works deliberated that 100 million Rupees for 17000 government houses was not sufficient, for their maintenance and repair. The Chairman Committee desired the concerned that the award of tenders and the contractors name ought to be provided to the Committee.

Accordingly, the instant Question stands disposed of.
