The Senate of Pakistan met in the Senate Hall (Parliament House) Islamabad at seventeen minutes past three in the evening with Mr. Presiding Officer (Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah) in the Chair.

### **Questions and Answers**

جناب پریذائیڈنگآ فیر: بیم اللدالر حمل الرحیم. Question hour. Question No. 47, Senator Shibli Faraz, Senator Shibli Faraz, Senator Shibli Faraz is not present. The answer placed on the Table of the House shall be taken as read.

@\*Question No. 47. Senator Syed Shibli Faraz: Will the Minister for Finance, Revenue, Economic Affairs, Statistics and Privatization be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any tax exemption will be given on various items to be exported by China under CPEC programme, if so, the estimated impact of the same on the country's manufacturing sector; and
- (b) the estimated impact on budget of the country due to provision of protection of Chinese road and sea convoys under the said programme?

Senator Muhammad Ishaq Dar (Minister for Finance, Revenue, Economic Affairs, Statistics and Privatization): INLAND REVENUE

No exemption from income tax, sales tax and Federal Excise Duty under the CPEC programme has been provided to the Chinese exports. However, exemption from income tax, sales tax and Federal Excise Duty has been provided for the following CPEC related projects:

- (i) Exemption from sales tax and federal excise duty to materials and equipment for construction and operation of Gwadar Port and Gwadar Free Zone has been provided through Finance Act, 2016. This exemption is equally available to imported as well as locally manufactured materials and equipment. In case of imports, the exemption is not specific to materials and equipment imported from China. Moreover, impact of exemption on country's manufacturing sector cannot be quantified before completion of the projects.
- (ii) Exemption from income tax and sales tax has been provided in respect of plant, machinery and equipment including dumpers and special vehicles motor imported for purpose construction of Sukkur-Multan Section and Thakot-Havellian section, parts of CPEC. To safeguard the interest of country's manufacturing sector, the exemption from sales tax has been provided to plant, machinery and equipment, etc. which are not manufactured. Moreover. locally this exemption is not specific to imports from China.
- (iii) Exemption from sales tax to equipment and material imported for Lahore Orange Line Metro Project has been provided. Exemption from the applicability of the provisions of

section 148 of the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 regarding advance income tax at import stage has been provided in respect of Rail Based Mass Transit Project in all the four Provincial Metropolis.

### **CUSTOMS**

Following exemptions from levy of customs duty at import stage are available specifically to the CPEC projects:—

- i. Exemption of customs duties on import of plant, machinery and equipment, if not manufactured locally, by M/s China State Construction Engineering Corporation Limited CSCECL) (M/s and bv M/s China Communication Construction Company (M/s CCCC) for the construction of Karachi -Peshawar Motorway (Sukkur – Multan Section) and for the construction of Karakorum Highway (KKH) Phase-II - (Thakot -Havellian Section) respectively vide Notification No. SRO 642(I)/2016, dated 27-07-2016 (Annex-A). The import data indicates that exemption of duty have been availed to the tune of Rs 1.86 billion under the said SRO in the period July-February, 2017.
- ii. Exemption of customs duty on import of equipment and material is available for the Lahore Orange Line Metro Train Project. As

per import data, no consignment has been cleared in this connection.

iii. Exemption of Customs duties on imports to the concession holder and its operating companies for Gwadar Port construction, operations and development and to all port related businesses established in the Gwadar Free Zone under Chapter 9917 (3) of the First Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969. No significant import has been affected under this regime (Annex-B).

2. Besides, following concessions/exemptions from levy of customs duty on import of goods are available to the various sectors/projects which can also be availed by the CPEC projects:—

- Concessionary rate of CD @ 0%, 3% & 5% for import of machinery, equipment, materials, capital goods etc., if not manufactured locally, is available for Mineral Exploration and Mine Construction Sectors under Sr. No. 6 & 7 of the Fifth Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969 respectively (Annex-C).
- Exemption of Customs Duty (CD) for coal mining machinery, equipment and spares etc, if not manufactured locally, is available for Thar Coal Field under Sr. No. 8 of the Fifth

Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969 and under SRO 268(I)/2015 dated 02-4-2015 (Annex-D).

iii. Concessionary rate of CD @ 0%, 3% & 5% for import of machinery, equipment and spares, if not manufactured locally, is available for Power Generation through oil, gas, coal, wind and wave energy under Sr. No.9, 10 & 11 of the Fifth Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969 (Annex-E).

3. Since all the concessions/exemptions at para 2 are subject to the condition that **the imported goods are not manufactured locally** (except Power Generation Plant of 25 MW and above; and Gwadar Port construction), therefore, local industry has been provided necessary cushion from impact of imports for CPEC project.

\*Question No. 189 Senator Mian Muhammad Ateeq Shaikh: Will the Minister for Finance, Revenue, Economic Affairs, Statistics and Privatization be pleased to state the names and details of documents required to establish a Private Limited Company and single Member company separately in the country?

Senator Muhammad Ishaq Dar: The details regarding names and documents required to establish a Private Limited Company and single Member Company separately with SECP are at annex-I.

### Detail of documents required to establish a P rivate Limited Company and Single Member Company under the Companies Ordinance, 1984.

### 1. Availability of name

- Seek "availability of name" for the proposed company from concerned registrar of companies.
- The name must not contain the prohibited words (list of prohibited words available on website of SECP).

### 1.1 Procedure, Fee and Application for Availability of name:

- · The application for name availability can be filed either online or offline.
- Follow link <u>https://eservices.secp.gov.pk/eServices/</u> for online submission of application for availability of name
- · Sign up to obtain the required User ID and Password and follow the instruction.
- · Application fee is Rs. 200 for online and 500 for offline mode.
- Offline name availability shall be applied directly to the concerned registrar along with prescribed offline fee.
- The fee can be paid in the designated branches of MCB Bank Limited through Challan which can be downloaded from: http://challan.secp.gov.pk/manualChalnGenrator/main.faces

### 2. Documents required for incorporation of a Private / Single Member Company

Any two or more persons may, by subscribing their names to the Memorandum of Association and complying with the requirements of the Ordinance for a private company.

The documents required to be submitted are listed as follows:

- 1. Memorandum & Articles of Association
- 2. Form- 1 (DECLARATION OF APPLICANT FOR INCORPORATION)
- Form-21 (NOTICE OF SITUATION OF REGISTERED OFFICE OR ANY CHANGE THEREIN)
- Form- 29 (PARTICULARS OF DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS, INCLUDING THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE, MANAGING AGENT, SECRETARY, CHIEF ACCOUNTANT, AUDITORS AND LEGAL ADVISER, OR OF ANY CHANGE THEREIN)
- 5. Special Power of Attorney on Stamp paper duly notarized.
- 6. Copy of Name Availability Letter issued by SECP.
- 7. Copies of CNIC of promoters and witness
- 8. Paid Challan of necessary registration and filing fee.

In case of a single member company, Article of Association must be adopted as per Form S-8 (Available on the website of SECP)

### 2.1 Step wise procedure registration of company

There are two modes available for incorporation of a company i.e. Online and Offline.

### 2.2 Step wise procedure registration of company (Online)

- Obtain User ID and Password by following the procedure provided at the link http://www.secp.gov.pk/eServices/eServices-UserID-Password.pdf
- ii) After login through main user, create additional User IDs, as required through Manage Company Users button available on the top right hand side of the web page. You will need to create separate User IDs for all proposed Subscribers in order to obtain their digital signatures.
- iii) Obtain digital signatures from the NIFT (Detailed Procedure, Application Forms and fee for obtaining digital signatures is attached (Annexure-G) Step-wise procedure for acquiring digital signature is available at https://secp.niftetrust.com/downloads/CRF SECP NewCompany.pdf
- iv) Log on to eServices at https://eservices.secp.gov.pk/eServices
- v) A successful logon to eServices by entering user ID and password, will display a list of available processes including "Company incorporation". Click the same and enter the information pertaining to the proposed company its sponsors/directors. Besides, attach and save PDF version of the documents like Memorandum and Articles of Association, copies of CNICs/Passports of the sponsors.
- vi) Click, open and save auto generated fee challan. Do not print Challan at this stage.
- vii) Click Sign Forms button; select and Sign Forms using the digital signatures obtained from NIFT. Every Subscriber needs to sign the forms by logging through his/her User ID.
- viii) Click Submit button. After your process is submitted, process reference number will pop up. Print a copy of this page for future reference.
- ix) Click the "Submitted Processes" button for challan print and pay the same in the designated branch of MCB.

### 2.3 Procedure for registration of company (offline)

The following documents are required to be filed with the registrar concerned for registration of a Public:-

### i) Memorandum and articles of association:

Four printed copies of Memorandum and Articles of Association duly signed by each subscriber in the presence of one witness. Stamp duty is levied on one copy each of Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association in I.C.T. at the rate Rs.60 and Rs. 200, respectively, in case incorporation of company through offline however, no stamp duty for online incorporation.

- Form 1 -Declaration of compliance with the pre-requisites for the formation of a company.
- iii) Form 21 Notice of situation of registered office of the company
- iv) Form 29 Particulars of first directors of the company
- Registration and filing fee: Original paid Challan evidencing the payment of registration fee and filing fee of above documents as in any of the authorized branches of MCB Bank Limited as under:
- vi) Copy of national identity card of each subscriber and witness to the memorandum and articles of association.
- vii) Authorization by sponsors:

The authorization of sponsors in favour of a person to make good the deficiencies, if any, in the memorandum and articles of association and other documents as may be pointed out by the registrar concerned and to collect the certificate of incorporation.

of course, it would have been a different situation whereas the specific provision for this purpose, in the old Companies Ordinance, 1984 as long as the membership is disclosed in the memorandum and articles of association. I don't believe there is any specific prohibition for a foreign director but I will have to check with the Secretary's Commission before I will give a definitive reply. Mr. Presiding Officer: Tahir Mashhadi Sahib.

Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: Thank you Mr. Chairman. I would like to ask the honourable Minister that once these companies are registered as a private limited company or a single member company; are they automatically brought into the tax net or what is the procedure?

Mr. Presiding Officer: Minister Sahib.

Mr. Zahid Hamid: Mr. Chairman, they are not automatically brought into the tax net. Of course, once they are registered and the record of that particular company when, as you know under the provisions of company law they are required to file returns and so on and have that return, which shows that they are required to pay tax, then indeed their tax will have to be paid.

\*Question No. 191 Senator Mian Muhammad Ateeq Shaikh: Will the Minister for Industries and Production be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there are no airbags in the cars being manufactured by the Suzuki company in the country; and
- (b) whether it is also a fact that said company charges premium on the urgent delivery of vehicles which makes the price of vehicle higher than its official retail price, if so, the reasons thereof and the steps being taken by the Government to stop the same?

Mr. Ghulam Murtaza Khan Jatoi (Minister for Industries and Production): (a) At present none of the Pak Suzuki model has Air Bags installed. Details are as under;

(b) It is to inform that the company is not charging any premium; however, dealers are responsible for charging premium on urgent delivery of vehicles.

The Ministry deals with assembly / manufacture of vehicles, however concerning consumer welfare and to

shorten delivery time Automotive Development Policy (2016-21) adopted following measure:

"Amount of advance payment shall be limited up to 50 percent of the total price. Price and delivery schedule, not exceeding two months, shall be firmed at the time of booking. Any delay over two months shall result in discount @ KIBOR+2 percent prevailing on the date of final delivery/settlement from the final payment, which shall help shorten delivery lead time"

Number two; they are taking all the money in advance and they are giving after four, five months delivery and yet the Government is not taking any action against them. Actually they are getting these engine parts completely unassembled, they are only assembling them here and they are calling this 'at local'.

\*Question No. 193 Senator Muhammad Talha Mahmood: Will the Minister for Industries and Production be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount allocated for developmental and non-developmental expenditures of the Ministry of Industries and Production, its attached departments, sub-ordinate offices, autonomous and semi-autonomous organizations and corporations during the fiscal year 2015-16;
- (b) the details of projects on which the said developmental expenditures where made; and

(c) the steps being taken by the Government to reduce the non-developmental expenditures of the said Ministry, its attached departments, sub-ordinate offices, autonomous and semiautonomous organizations and corporations?

Mr. Ghulam Murtaza Khan Jatoi: (a) Development:

- i. An amount of Rs. 790.881 million was allocated to twenty three (23) on going PSDP projects of Ministry of Industries & Production during the Fiscal Year 2015-16.
- ii. Non-Development:

An amount of Rs. 992.000 million was allocated to Ministry of Industries & Production and its attached departments during the Fiscal Year 2015-16 (Annex-I).

(b) The project wise detail of allocation, expenditure and present status alongwith name of executing agencies is at (Annex-II).

(c) Ministry of Industries & Production took the following steps to reduce the non-developmental expenditures during financial year 2015-2016:—

• Instructions for austerity measures issued by Finance Division were observed in letter and spirit.

- Quarterly releases of funds to five (5) organizations / corporations working under Ministry of Industries & Production were released after obtaining complete details of expenditure of quarter last ended duly verified by the concerned sub-offices of AGPR and the statements of the Assignment Accounts issued by the National Bank maintaining their assignment accounts.
- Regular meetings are held in the Ministry under the chairmanship of Secretary/PAO Ministry of Industries and Production to review the expenditure under different heads of accounts and workout the savings which are utilized under other heads/demands where budgetary shortfall occurres instead of demanding Supplementary Grants etc.
- All the organizations have been directed to make efforts for increase in their revenue receipts and curtail their non-development expenditures and strictly observe the austerity measures of the Government.

\*Question No. 195 Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati: Will the Minister for Finance, Revenue, Economic Affairs, Statistics and Privatization be pleased to state:

- (a) the names, grades and place of domicile of officers working in the Regional Development Finance Corporation (RDFC); and
- (b) the procedure adopted for appointment of the said officers?

Senator Muhammad Ishaq Dar: (a) Under Regional Development Finance Corporation and Small Business Finance Corporation (Amalgamation & Conversion) Ordinance 2001, Regional Development Finance Corporation (RDFC) and Small Business Finance Corporation (SBFC) were amalgamated on January 01, 2002 and SME Bank was established. Both the Government institutions *i.e.* RDFC and SBFC do not exist anymore.

(b) The appointments of the employees of defunct RDFC and SBFC were made in accordance with prescribed method in vogue at that time. After amalgamation, 180 regular employees of both defunct

organizations *i.e.* RDFC and SBFC were transferred to SME Bank and are now working there since 01st January, 2002.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Any supplementary?

Senator Muhammad Ishaq Dar: Benazir Income Support Programme (BISP) has initiated a process of resurvey/National Socio Economic Registry (NSER) update in order to recertify old beneficiaries and to include new ones. Balochistan is also included in the re-survey.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Next question Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi.

\*Question No. 198 Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: Will the Minister for Finance, Revenue, Economic Affairs, Statistics and Privatization be pleased to state the details of tax exemptions or incentive packages being given to industrialists in FATA?

Senator Muhammad Ishaq Dar:

### **INCOME TAX**

The profits or gains derived by a taxpayer located in areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Federally Administered Tribal Area (FATA) and Provincially Administered Tribal Area (PATA) affected by war on terror were granted exemption from income tax for a period of three year starting from tax year 2010 through insertion of clause 126F, Part-I of the Second Schedule to the income tax Ordinance.

*Vide* Finance Act, 2015, clause (126L) of Part I of Second Schedule to the Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 has been added, whereby profits and gains derived by a taxpayer, from an industrial undertaking set up between 1st day of July 2015 to 30th day of June, 2018, in the whole of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa including FATA, have been granted exemption for a period of five years, starting from the day of commencement of their commercial operations. The aforesaid Industrial undertakings have also been granted exemption from payment of minimum tax on their turnover under clause (11A)(xxv) of Part IV of the Second Schedule.

Similarly profits and gains derived by a taxpayer from fruit processing and preservation unit set up in certain backward areas including Malakand Division and FATA have also been exempted from income tax with effect from July 2014 to, 30th June 2017 under clause 126H.

### SALES TAX:

Exemption from sales tax to plant, machinery and equipment imported for setting up industries in FATA upto 30th June, 2019 has been provided under S. No. 116 of Table-1 of Sixth Schedule to the Sales Tax Act, 1990 subject to the same conditions and procedure as are applicable for import of such plant, machinery and equipment under the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969).

### CUSTOMS

In order to promote industrialization, job creation and economic uplift of the less developed regions, exemption of customs duty has been allowed on import of plant, machinery and equipment imported during the period commencing on 1-7-2014 and ending on 30-6-2019 for setting up industries in FATA *vide* Sr. No. 26 of Fifth Schedule to the Customs Act, 1969 **(Annex-A).** The imports valuing Rs. 66 million under this concession involving exemption of customs duty to the tune of Rs. 2 million have been effected during July2016 - February, 2017.

Provided that the condition of "local manufacturing" shall not be applicable on import of machinery, equipment and other capital goods imported as plant for setting up of a new power unit of 25 MW and above duly certified by Ministry of Water and Power in respect of those power projects which are on IPP mode meant for supply of electricity to national grid;

- (ii) except for S. Nos. 1(1f), 14, 20, and 21 of the Table, the Chief Executive, or the person next in hierarchy duly authorized by the Chief Executive or Head of the importing company shall certify in the prescribed manner and format as per Annex-A that the imported items are the company's bona fide requirement. He shall furnish all relevant information online to Pakiatan Customs Computerized System against a specific user ID and password obtained under section 155D of the Customs Act, 1969 IV of 1969). In already computerized Collectorates or Customs stations where the Pakistan Customs Computerized System is not operational, the Director Reforms and Automation or any other person authorized by the Collector in this behalf shall enter the requisite information in the Pakistan Customs Computerized System on daily basis, whereas entry of the data obtained from the customs stations which have not yet been computerized shall be made on weekly basis.
- (iii) in case of partial shipments of machinery and equipment for setting up a plant, the importer shall, at the time of arrival of first partial shipment, furnish complete details of the machinery, equipment and components required for the complete plant, duly supported by the contract, lay out plan and drawings and

Mr. Presiding Officer: Any supplementary? Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: Thank you, Mr. Chairman! I would like to ask the honourable Minister that according to the reply given the Income Tax relief was given to FATA in 2010 for three years. Does it still exist? If it is not still in existing why not, how do you expect FATA to develop without incentives? Thank you Mr. Chairman.

Mr. Zahid Hamid: Thank you sir. Sir, as has been stated in the reply, honourable Senator Sahib, may kindly see that whereas the first incentive given to FATA in income tax, in the first paragraph of the reply is an incentive given for all persons affected by War on Terror from Income Tax for a period of three years from 2010 to 2013. That is correct, but if he were to read the 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph also he will see then that this has been broadened and now the profits and gains, the right ways a taxpayers from an industrial undertaking set up between 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2015 to 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2018, in the whole of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa including FATA, have been granted exemption for a period of five years. So, now this exemption is from 2015 to 2018 for the period of five years and this is only Income Tax. If you would then look at the sales tax exemption, he will find in the next section that the FATA has been exempted from sales tax on plant, machinery and equipment imported upto 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2019. So, this exemption is also subsisting and finally if you would look at the section of customs again in order to promote industrialization in the backward areas including FATA the customs duty has been exempted on import of plant, machinery and equipment for industries in FATA. So, there is a comprehensive list of exemptions given to these areas.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati Sahib.

Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati: Sir, what safety measures we have in place where somebody wants to import plant, machinery and equipment in the name of FATA are not being misused at any other place?

Mr. Zahid Hamid: I assume that these will be applying in this area is that when the plant and machinery arrive at the port, they are given the exemption and a guaranty which is redeemed only after the industry is actually set up. So, they have to produce what you may call a completion certificate that a plant and machinery has been installed at the sight for which it was imported.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Senator Nauman Wazir Sahib.

Senator Nauman Wazir Khattak: Thank you very much sir. I am awestruck and bewildered by this answer. Sir, 126(F) was applicable to whole of Pakistan, three other exemptions and 126(L) was for FATA and KPK but what surprises me is the Income Tax Ordinance itself has not been extended to FATA. What exemption are they talking about?

The Income Tax Ordinance is not extended. What is this answer? And I would request to please give a final ruling, if this is right or wrong. And if it is wrong answer, then it should be referred to the Committee for giving such a wrong answer.

Mr. Presiding Officer: Yes, Minister Sahib.

Mr. Zahid Hamid: The written answer which has been provided by the Ministry and which is that the Clause 126(L) of the Finance Act, 2015 applies for industrial undertaking set up between the first day of July 2015 to the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2018 in the whole of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and this also includes FATA but because of the very clear position taken by the honourable Senator, let me again, by way of abundant caution confirm from the Ministry of Finance that this is indeed the case. If this is not correct, I myself will lay the full corrected position, not only inform the honourable Senator but also will be laid in the House.

Mr. Presiding Officer: So, what we will do basically is we defer the question and I give you chance to ascertain what additional facts are. So, we defer the question for next Session.

The next question No.200 is in the name of Senator Sirajul Haq Sahib. Senator Sirajul Haq is not present so the answer would be taken as read and placed on the Table of the House.

\*Question No. 200 Senator Sirajul Haq: Will the Minister for Finance, Revenue, Economic Affairs, Statistics and Privatization be pleased to state the percentage increase registered in the prices of basic edible items since July, 2013 and the salient reasons thereof?

Senator Muhammad Ishaq Dar: The percentage increase or decrease in **73 basic edible items**, out of 487 items, **since July 2013** has been calculated and placed is annexed.

The average annual increase in prices of these 73 perishable items since July, 2013 is 4.37 percent compared to food inflation of 5.14 percent.

## The reasons are as follows:

- (i) The general increase in food inflation.
- (ii) Annual variation in production, acreage and yields.
- (iii) Exchange rate variation and demand/ supply imbalances.

\*Question No. 201 Senator Sirajul Haq: Will the Minister for Industries and Production be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of utility stores established in the country with province and district wise break up;
- (b) the criteria laid down for establishing a utility store in an area; and
- (c) the mechanism devised for ensuring the quality and quantity of items being sold at those stores?

Mr. Ghulam Murtaza Khan Jatoi: (a) At present USC is operating 5265 stores. Province and District wise break up of Regular Stores and Franchise Utility Stores is as under:—

- (i) 4410 regular stores are operating all over the Pakistan. Province wise and district wise details is at Annexure-A.
- (ii) 855 franchise stores are operating. Province wise and district wise detail is at Annexure-B.
- (b) Availability of bank facility.
  - Availability of commercially viable location.
  - Law and order situation.
  - Peaceful situation for stock and staff.
  - Area for convenience stores is 500 sqft up to 1000sqft.

- Area for Mini Markets is 1000 sqft up to 2000 sqft.
- Road facility.

## (c) **BRANDED ITEMS**

- Branded Items (being produced and manufactured under any brand name *i.e.* Nestle, Unilever, P&G etc) are procured directly from manufacturers/ producers.
- These companies stand warrantee on the quality and quantity of the items provided by them.
- Corporation executes agreements with concerned vendor/supplier, under which the vendor is fully responsible for quality and quantity of the product.
- All items under any brand name falling under compulsory list of Pakistan Standard Quality Control Authority (PSQCA) are procured subject to production of valid certificate of registration of the PSQCA.

## Non-Branded Items

- USC Head Office collects the demand of Sugar, Rice and Pulses from USC Regions on monthly basis.
- Utility Stores Corporation is purchasing stocks through open competitive bidding by floating

the tenders in the press in accordance with rules framed by PPRA.

- Tenders / bids are opened by the Tender Committee Comprising:
  - o Sr. General Manager (Coord) Chairman,
  - o Chief Operating Officer Member
  - o Chief Financial Officer Member
  - o General Manager (Procurement) -Member
  - o One Member from the Ministry of Industries & Productions.
- The Committee at the time of opening of bids/tenders analyses and examines the samples thoroughly so as to make the selection of good quality product.
- The samples of Rice are also checked / examined through cooking/boiling.
- Purchase Order are issued as per the demand collected from the USC Zone/ Regions.
- The approved samples are delivered to Regional Managers/ Warehouse Incharges who unload the stock after proper examining by the Regional Committee in accordance with the approved samples.

- In case of difference in quality, the stock is rejected and returned to the vendors.
- While making procurement of Spices items, USC Tender Committee examines the samples and selects only those items which are found according to USC's requirement and specification.
- The successful bidders/ vendors are bound to deliver the stock according to approved/selected samples.
- In case the quality of stock is not found as per samples, the committee comprising A.O (Project), Project Officer and I/C Warehouse Spices rejects the stock and returns the same to the concerned vendor at his own risk and cost.
- By adopting the above mechanism, USC receives good quality Spices items and rules out the delivery of low/ inferior quality items. (Annexures have been placed on the Table of the House as well as Library.)

## Presentation of Report of the Select Committee on Right to Information Bill,2016 by Senator Farhatullah Babar

Senator Farhatullah Babar: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, I the Chairman of the Select Committee on the Right to Information Bill, 2016, wish to present report of the Committee on the Bill to provide for the right to information in a rapid and low-cost manner subject only to reasonable restrictions established by law [The Right to Information Bill, 2016], introduced by Senator Kamil Ali Agha on 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2016.

Senator Farhatullah Babar: Mr. Chairman, sometimes back this House had nominated a Special Committee to work on the Right to Information Bill, 2016 and the reason for that was at the Information Committee of the Senate had prepared a Bill RTI, 2016 and the government also had made its own Bill.

When you set up this Committee about six weeks ago, this Committee held a number of meetings. We considered both the Bills and finally the Committee decided that we will make amendments to the Bill presented by the Government.

Mr. Chairman, I am very happy and delighted to inform that this Committee has arrived at a unanimous decision on the Right to Information Bill. This is not only unanimous but it also is far reaching in the sense that not only the Federal Government departments are obliged to provide information on asking but also the Parliament, the Judiciary and all those NGOs which receive funding in one form or the other from the Federal Government, they also under the ambit of this law. Mr. Chairman, the second characteristic of this law is that until now for the past sixty seven years, information was withheld from the public on grounds of so-called national security. For the first time, a provision has been made in this law that blanket immunity in the name of national security will not be granted. The Committee while considering this aspect, relied on Johannesburg Principles of 1993 which are universally recognized and which draw a distinction, while considerations of national security and the public good.

So, this Bill envisages that in case information is withheld on grounds of national security, then officer concerned will have to give a written statement as to why does he consider, that the considerations of national security out-way the considerations of public good. When he gives that reason in writing, even then the information seeker is entitled to appeal against this before the Information Commission.

Mr. Chairman, secondly, not only that but issues involving corruption and issues that involve the life and liberty of a citizen, if they are involved then the provision of national security will not be invoked, it cannot be invoked under this law to seek exemption of that information.

Mr. Chairman, what we have done in this Bill is to appeal against the decision of the Government to withhold information. An Information Commission has been envisaged comprising of three members. Of course, the powers to appoint the Information Commission have been given to the Prime Minister but again here, the Prime Minister is not given the blanket powers. He cannot appoint all the three members from one strata of the society. He has to choose three members from three different strata of the society; one retired ex-bureaucrat, civil-military bureaucracy, one from retired Judges and third one from the civil society. While the Prime Minister has the powers to appoint the members of the Commission, he shall have no powers to dismiss them. The power to remove them shall vest with the Parliament. So, this also, Mr. Chairman is a very significant feature of this Right to Information Bill. There is also a provision that if a Government official willfully destroys official record with a view to hold that information from a seeker, then in that case, which will be a penal offence, it carries jail sentence of 2 years.

Mr. Chairman, you also have laid it obligatory to publish the official record. The publication of record also includes and Mr. Chairman, mark my words, it also includes the lands and plots allotted, the licenses given and all these kinds of privileges which are given, they will also be made public.

Mr. Chairman, another interesting feature is that this law overwrites all other laws so that the mischief of the out dated Official Secret Act, 1923 does not come into play. We have endeavoured to give a law which, for the first time, will address the issues, for the first time will address those issues behind which information was withheld from the public but no matter Mr. Chairman, whatever we may do, it will all depend on the mindset, when the culture is that of a secrecy, it becomes very difficult that even issue make fool proof laws, even then, the culture of secrecy, particularly, in the powerful fractions of the society, they might prevail upon withholding information.

Mr. Chairman, all that we have done in the past questions asked like whether an inquiry was held in the Kargil incident. It was killed because it involves according to that time, an issue of national security. A question asked that whether there is a law under which the ISI operates, it was killed because it was said that it involves a question of national security.

So, Mr. Chairman, now such types of questions cannot be killed behind just a sort of national security because a law now clearly forbids. However, I don't know whether questions like this will be killed by the powerful people, by the powerful sections of the society just because of the mind-set. All that we can give is to make the law. The implementation of the law will depend on the Executive. I hope and earnestly urge all including the powerful and the less powerful, that when the law is made to abide by the law.

Mr. Chairman, finally I want to thank you for setting up this Committee. I want to thank all the honourable Members of the Committee and also the honourable Minister of State, Ms. Maryam Aurangzeb, who was very cooperative in accommodating our suggestions. I also want to thank the Secretariat, Ms. Qurat-ul-Ain, Secretary Committee, who did a great job. Thank you very much Mr. Chairman, now I beg to lay this report.

Senator Farhatullah Babar: I, as Chairman, Select Committee on the Right to Information Bill, 2016, present report of the Committee on the Bill to provide for the right to information in a rapid and low-cost manner subject only to reasonable restrictions established by law [The Right to Information Bill, 2016], introduced by Senator Kamil Ali Agha on 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2016.

Mr. Chairman: The report stands laid. Muzafar Hussain Shah Sahib.

#### Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah

Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah: Sir, in fact, this Bill that has been tabled, is a very historic Bill. It opens up the venues for ordinary citizens in Pakistan to have access to information as contemplated by Article 19A of the Constitution. In fact, the Committee in its deliberations had asked for a comparative statement of similar provisions which were pending in neighbouring countries Malaysia, India. After consideration of the statement, the Committee comparative in its deliberations decided to adopt these provisions of the Bill which will go a long way in serving democracy, transparency and open-mindedness.

I would also like to place on record that the Bill was initiated by the then Minister for Information, Senator Pervaiz Rasheed and the Minister of State for Information, Marriyam Aurangzeb. The proceedings of the Committee were presided over by Senator Farhatullah Babar. The unanimous view of this Committee has an indication that Senate had played a pivotal role in legislating issues which have paramount importance to the people of Pakistan. Thank you sir.

Mr. Chairman, It is indeed a proud privilege of the Senate of Pakistan and you are the head of the Senate, that such a large number of our brothers and sisters came from all over Asia to participate in a three days meeting about how to proceed further on practical lines to create an Asian Parliament consisting members of the states and we are satisfied and we appreciate the efforts of all the participants that they have not only inched forward but they have particularly covered a very long distance to achieve their object. It is not a secret now that Asians are determined to have their own sources within their own hands and they want actually to formulate their own future policies without the pressure of the powers of the world which had previously violated our rights and they have also gathered from these areas, the precious matters as well as the resources of Asian people.

We are grateful to them that they have taken this array and they have participated in this conference and I

hope within the shortest possible time their objective would be *In Sha Allah* achieved. I thank you very much.

Mr. Chairman: Thank you. While you were speaking just as a last remark, while you were speaking the thought came to me that after this meeting of the Standing Committee and substantive progress being made with reference to the creation of an Asian Parliament, I think Western Capitals, I think I will speak on behalf of all the delegates that Western Capitals should realize that the slogans that they are now raising vis-à-vis immigration and refugees, if Asia was to raise the slogan of Asia for Asians then they would have no place to stand.

We now move back to Order No.3. Order No.3 are adjournment motions. The first adjournment motion stands in the name of Senator Chaudhary Tanvir Khan. Senator Chaudhary Tanvir. Senator Chaudhary Tanvir, is not present the motion is dropped. Before, I take up adjournment motion No.2. There was, I am given to understand that yesterday there was an adjournment motion that had been moved which was with reference to profiling and that was admitted with due respect to the Presiding Officer, I think, perhaps the facts were not before him. The question that was raised in the adjournment motion had been debated upon in the last session. It has been raised on a point of public interest. It had been then moved as a calling attention notice, the Minister had come and given a comprehensive reply and when there was in camera briefing on the law and order situation, this question was at that time also addressed, therefore, this adjournment motion was hit by the rules that a matter that has already been discussed in the House and less than 6<sup>th</sup> months have passed cannot become the subject matter of another discussion. But despite that the motion was adopted, since it has been brought to my notice, therefore, with due respect to the Presiding Officer under the powers conferred on the Chair under Rule 264, I rescind the order of the admission of the adjournment motion yesterday.

We now move on to adjournment motion No. 2. Adjournment motion No. 2, stands in the name of Senator Lt. Gen. (Retd.) Abdul Qayyum and Mohsin Aziz. Senator Lt. Gen. (Retd.) Abdul Qayyum.

## Adjournment Motion moved by Senator Lt. Gen. (Retd.) Abdul Qayyum regarding Ex-Ambassador to the USA made a Confession Statement

Senator Lt. Gen. (Retd.) Abdul Qayyum: I wish to move an adjournment motion on an urgent public matter which needs to be discussed in the House regarding one of our Ex-Ambassadors to United States of America Mr. Hussain Haqani confession through his article published in Washington Post on 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2017, with regard to facilitation of CIA agents' discrete induction into Pakistan with the approval of the country's political leadership in power at that time.

Mr. Chairman, I feel that as per Rule 87, the condition of admissibility of the motion of Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business, I think that it is very important subject. It is of extreme public interest because one of our Ambassadors in the most important country of the world sitting there is confessing that he has been facilitating induction of agents into country.

Number two, it is a recent occurrence because his confession is very recent. Then this matter is not being discussed any time within the last four months. This matter concerns to the Government interests. It does not pertain to his personal character, it pertains to his official capacity and in his public capacity. It does not relate to a matter of privilege, it is not hypothetical and on this it cannot be solved with legislation and there is no pending matter on this issue in the court of law. Therefore, I feel that we should have allocated some time to discuss this issue and to reach those conclusions as to how a person from Pakistan, representing us abroad as an ambassador could really facilitate induction of agents into the country, which is against the national security interest of Pakistan. So, therefore, I urge you, sir, to accept this for deliberations in the Senate. Thank you very much.

Mr. Chairman: Thank you. I am given to understand through the media today that this matter has become the subject matter of a petition before the Supreme Court of Pakistan. But nonetheless, regardless of that, I find the motion to be in order and fix it for a two hours discussion as the last item.....

Mr. Chairman: You can't object. Please resume your seat. Resume your seat. I find the motion to be in order and fix it for discussion as the last item on the agenda on Tuesday.

# Presentation of report of the Standing Committee on Climate Change by Senator Samina Abid regarding Pakistan Climate Change Bill, 2017

Senator Samina Abid: Thank you sir. I on behalf of Senator Mir Muhammad Yousaf Badini, Chairman Standing Committee on Climate Change, wish to present report of the Committee on the Bill to meet Pakistan's obligations under international conventions relating to climate change and address the effects of climate change, The Pakistan Climate Change Bill, 2017.

Mr. Chairman: The report stands laid. We now move on to Order No.6. Order No.6 stands in the name of Senator Mushahid Ullah Khan. Senator Muzafar Hussain Shah on his behalf.

# Motion Under Rule 196(1) moved by Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah on behalf of Convenor, Special Committee regarding Overall Performance of PIA

Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah: Sir, on behalf of Senator Mushahid Ullah Khan, the Convener of the Special Committee on the performance of PIA, I do move under sub-Rule (1) of Rule 196 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the second interim report of the Special Committee regarding the overall performance of PIA, presented in the House on 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2017, be considered and adopted.

# Mr. Chairman: Is there anyone who would like to speak on this? Yes, Senator Abdul Qayyum. <u>Senator Lt. Gen. (Retd.) Abdul Qayyum</u>

Senator Lt. Gen. (Retd.) Abdul Qayyum: Thank you very much Mr. Chairman. Sir, I was one of the members of the Special Committee and I also had the honour to visit the PIA setup and we had detailed briefing from different departments and in addition to getting that briefing, we also interviewed the Ex-Chairman and the Ex-M.Ds of Pakistan International Airlines. When we came back to Islamabad, we met the last 3 or 4 ex-DGs, Civil Aviation and we collected all these information. On this our Leader, Muzafar Hussain Shah Sahib has already explained most of the things but what I would like to say and apprise the House is that this country has a population of 200 million and out of that about 90 million people are living abroad in the entire world, in all the 06 or 07 Continents of the world. So, therefore, there is lot of pressure of passengers in this country and I, therefore, feel that our airline, the only airline in the public sector has a tremendous potential to deliver but despite that it has not been able to do that and the reason is mismanagement and lack of governance.

So, therefore, in this report, we have recommended that we need to do the financial restructuring, the manpower restructuring and change the board of directors and we should have people in the board of directors who are professionals, who can contribute. We can revisit our Aviation Policy and see where this Pakistan International Airline needs our help and I feel that if that is provided, this airline can become as good and better as any airline in the world. Thank you very much.

Mr. Chairman: Is there anyone else who would like to speak? Yes, Senator Mashhadi.

#### Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi

Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. First of all I would like to compliment the Special Committee, Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah sahib, Senator Qayyum and Senator Farhatullah Babar. They really went deep into the working of PIA and the recommendations they have given are absolutely the basic necessity on which the revival of PIA can be started.

PIA was one of the finest and the best airlines in the world. It is the father or the mother airline of Emirates and Qatar Airways. In fact, we created Emirates. We gave them the pilots, we gave them the know-how, we gave them the ticketing staff, we gave them the engineering staff and now they have become one of the best airlines in the world while we have gone down the ladders so badly that it is almost a joke now. It was a very surprising thing that the very basic things required, there is, of course, the political interference but there is also mal-administration, there is favouritism, there is incompetent leadership, there is absolutely disinterested lot of people at the helm of affairs. The credit goes to you for establishing this Committee and going deep into the matter. We are coming up with very, very strange type of happenings in PIA. There is a case of the missing aircraft. A nuclear power's aircraft has somehow or the other landed in Germany in a Museum and the PIA Directors and the PIA Management were able to give no satisfactory answer to the Senate Committee that has it been sold. No, it has not been sold as yet and no money has been paid. However, on the way of its going to Germany, the aircraft was used to play an anti-Palestine film and for that they were paid some amount. Nobody understood that under whose permission, the Board of Directors knows nothing about it. Nobody knew anything about it and then the aircraft was supposed to be purchased by Germany, just the structure, and the whole aircraft, the engine, the seats and everything landed there and they have still not paid any amount whatsoever to the coffers of PIA.

So, that is one thing, the people have been hired at exuberant pay scales. Everybody is getting 18 lakhs, 20 lakhs, 40 lakhs and the Managing Director is drawing a salary of 30 lakh rupees with other facilities, which goes to about 50 lakhs rupees a month and he is hardly seen in Pakistan. It is very strange.

So, we have to admit that once again it is the Senate which has taken the lead, it is once again the Senate Committee which has unearthed it and lot of things that should have not been going wrong. There should have been some sort of monitoring. There should have been some sort of management to not let these things happen which are happening in PIA today. We hope that the ratification process will start and the recommendations of the Special Committee will be adhere to in letter and spirit because that is the way forward and that is the only way we can rescue this airline. But once again, it is our duty, of course, as Senators and as the watchdog of the nation, you can call us, as the Upper House to ensure the things go well and absolute variants from all rules and regulations and everything is not done and this is one case where the Committee deserves to be acknowledged for its excellent work. Thank you Mr. Chairman.

Mr. Chairman: Senator Abdul Rehman MalikSahib you are on the Committee PIA.

#### Senator Abdul Rehman Malik

Senator Abdul Rehman Malik: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, for giving me the opportunity. Let me put on record, appreciation to the Chairman Committee, Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah and his two members. It is a matter of national interest.

Will we take some action? Will the case be registered? Will they be punished for it? I hope this report has it since I have not read but if it is not there I would urgently request you Mr. Chairman, that this particular matter should be referred to the authority concerned for registration of a case, setting up precedent that nobody next time takes our plane without proper procedure to be observed.

Mr. Chairman: The report stands adopted. Before I take up Order No. 7, the Chair recognizes the presence of a delegation of members of the provincial assemblies, the Secretaries and the officials of the assemblies from the provinces of Punjab, Sindh, Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, who are sitting in the galleries. We welcome them especially because they are also constituents. We now take up Order No. 7. Order No. 7 stands in the name of Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah.

## Motion under Rule 196 (1) moved by Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah regarding Demands of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa

Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah: Sir, this is the Committee which you were pleased to form. Initially, it went to the eight Standing Committees. The reports were found to be unsatisfactory. Thereafter you are pleased to form a Special Committee on the 24 demands which were made by the Chief Minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. After extensive deliberations and after hearing the Ministries of the Federal Government and the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the Committee has been pleased to formulate these recommendations which even the members from the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government have praised as being a quality oriented report which seeks to protect the rights of the provinces within the federation. If the recommendations are adopted, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government's demands which were made to you, the 24 demands a lot would be realized. I would especially like to place on record the contribution of Senators Taj Haider, Abdul Rehman Malik, the Secretary Special Committee, Ms. Zargona Shabbir and the staff which helped us in formulating these recommendations.

Mr. Chairman: Is there anyone who would like to speak on this? Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati.

#### <u>Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati</u>

Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati: Mr. Chairman, while representing Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, I am bound as a duty and responsibility to again acknowledge your efforts that when Chief Minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa visited the out gate and he was looking towards the Senate so that his demands can be fulfilled. Shah Sahib and his committee have addressed all those issues. I am pretty much sure that within a given time those demands are going to be implemented in letter and spirit and I really appreciate for that. Thank you.

> Mr. Chairman: Thank you. Tahir Hussain Mashhadi. Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi

Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: Thank you. Mr. Chairman, I also take this opportunity that in this matter your role has been as usual one of a leader, one of an achiever. When nobody was listening to one of our federating units who under the Constitution of Pakistan have all rights to be heard. They have the right to demand, not only demand, it is their right, it is to be given not as a favour but as a constitutional obligation

so that they can govern for the betterment of the people of that particular federating unit of whichever the Government is in power. Somehow or the other, this Government failed or refused to listen to one of our federating units, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and it was a terrible state of affairs, it was unconstitutional of the Government not to listen to them, not to solve their problems, not to give them proper hearing, not to give them proper respect, not to give them the honour and dignity that they deserve and they were forced to go on the streets and when they went on the streets, then nobody listened. Either they did not listen or if they listened, they did not understand and if they understood, they did not want to help only because it was a particular province and as luck would have it or as misfortune would have it, it was governed by an opposition party to the government.

We have to respect the mandate of each and every federating unit. The people of a particular province have the right to elect a Government of their choice and that Government has a right to govern in the way it seems fit because it has the mandate to rule. To deny that mandate is to deny the constitutional right, is to put at stake the federation of Pakistan and I must congratulate you sir, that when they came knocking on the doors of the Senate, it was of course the honourable members, the collective wisdom of this House who felt that they should be helped but it was you who showed the courage and the way, you knew the way, you showed the way and we went away. It was the Senate which took up their case as our own case, as we are supposed to do

because we are the custodian of the provinces of Pakistan. These wonderful nationalities of Pakistan which make this beautiful bouquet and if you ignore one nationality, if you ignore one province, if you ignore one federating unit, you are putting the whole of the Pakistani structure, the integrity, the solidarity, the future of our children at stake. When you took this initiative, you give it to the committees hoping that the committees do their job. Some committees did, I have the honour of chairing the Committee of Planning and Development but unfortunately the 24 points were split up because they dealt with different committees and ministries so we could not do justice and we were not getting the response and then again you put your foot down, you said that the response will be forthcoming from the Government and the Government did respond and then you form the special committee. That special committee has done an excellent job, there is no doubt about it and it has been appreciated even by the province concerned and lesson to be learnt is that this is House of the Federation and we will look after each and every province and each and every nationality which constitute this great land of ours with equality, under the Constitution, under the law of the land we will ensure each and everyone gets according to his rights. In this case, I hope that we have satisfied a sisterly province and the credit once again goes to the Senate and I want to give a message to all the provinces that this is your House, when nobody listens to you, come to the Senate and the Senate will listen, work and fight for you. Thank you.

Mr. Chairman: Thank you. In all fairness the Minister for Finance did sit with the Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and some of their demands were addressed by the Federal Government as well. Mohisn Aziz Sahib.

#### Senator Mohsin Aziz

Mr. Chairman: It has been moved under sub-Rule (1) of Rule 196 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the report of the Special Committee on 24 demands made by the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa presented in the House on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2017, be adopted.

Mr. Chairman: We now move on to Order No. 8 which stands in the name of Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi.

## <u>Calling Attention Notice moved by Senator Col (R) Syed</u> <u>Tahir Hussain Mashhadi regarding Business Activities in</u> <u>Residential Areas of Islamabad</u>

Senator Col (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi: Thank you Chairman. I wish to call the attention of the honourable Minister for Capital Administration and Development Division, under Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012. On a matter of urgent public importance regarding nearly one hundred guest houses, private schools, media houses, hostels for men and women which are still operating in the residential areas of Islamabad Capital Territory despite a ban on the nonconforming use of residential properties. Honourable Supreme Court ordered end to all business activities in residential properties in Islamabad two years ago.

After which the Capital Development Authority closed down nearly a thousand clinics, media house offices and guest houses. However, many such more businesses are still operating in the city's residential sectors under the nose of the officials of CDA. It is not understood as to why a lenient view is being taken by the Building Control Directorate, CDA, towards the owners of these guest houses and private schools. The pattern of operation by CDA against guest houses is most haphazard, two or three in one sector one day and then one or two more in another sector are raided and then nothing happens. The operation against guest houses and other small businesses violating the law, should be carried out in accordance to the honourable Supreme Court's order in letter and spirit.

Will the honourable Minister apprise the house as to why strict and across the board action is not being launched and the orders of the honourable Supreme Court have not been complied with. When will all the commercial businesses operating illegally in residential areas of Islamabad be closed down. So, that the residents can live free from disturbances, security risks and harassment at par with other capital cities of the world. Thank you.

## Mr. Chairman: Honourable Minister. Sheikh Aftab Ahmed, Minister for Parliamentary Affairs
