- (b) the number of applications received by the present Government from foreign Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) for seeking permission to work in health sector in Pakistan; and*
- (c) whether there is any proposal under consideration of the Government to grant permission/exemption to foreign NGOs interested to work on prevention and control of Covid-19 pandemic in Pakistan, if so, details thereof?*

**Sheikh Rashid Ahmed:** (a) There is no health related INGO, which closed its operations in Pakistan during previous Government regime.

(b) Total 08 INGOs applied for registration. Their cases are under process. List is placed at **Annex-I**.

(c) 71 INGOs cases are under consideration to work on prevention and control of Covid-19 in Pakistan with NDMA/PDMA.

**Mr. Mohammad Azam Khan Swati:** (a) The Railway Un-manned Level crossing No.98 was shifted from Km. 184/12-13 to 185/9-10 into class-II manned level crossing on the request of Provincial Government after issuance of NOC by DCO/ Faisalabad.

(b) Once any un-manned level crossing is shifted and up-graded into manned level crossing on the same block section, the existing un-manned level crossing has to close, in term of Railway policy No. 128-W/0/Policy/W-I dated 23-2-2019, re-opening of the un-manned (Route to Chak No.190 RB Karari Kalan) is not permissible under the rules.

**Sheikh Rashid Ahmed:** (a) 398,560 PWDs (Persons with Disability) have been registered with NADRA. Province wise count of PWDs is attached as (**Annex-A**). Disability wise count of registered PWDs with/without Logo is attached as (**Annex-B**).

(b) Count of unregistered PWDs is not available with NADRA. However, we have taken following initiatives to ease out CNIC issuance to PWDs.

- First time CNIC is issued free of cost.
- CNICs are issued with life time expiry.
- Priority processing through queue jump.
- Introduction of Man Pack/MRVs to process such persons at their doorsteps.
- Separate/ dedicated counter have been established at each NADRA Centre.
- Availability of Wheel Chairs and ramp at each NADRA Centre.

*Will the Minister for Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state whether it is a fact that the Government has allocated Rs. 200 billion for a project called “Modernization of camera and production equipment of Pakistan Television Corporation”, if so, the mode of utilization of this amount until now?*

**Mr. Fawad Ahmed:** Government has not allocated Rs. 200 billion for the project. However, in 2018 a PSDP funded project titled as “Modernization of Camera and Production Equipment of PTV” was approved with an estimated cost of Rs. 555.59 Million. The project is successfully being executed by procuring equipment on competitive bid basis and establishment of letter of Credit (L/C).

**Sheikh Rashid Ahmed:** (a) At Present CDA has been using normal low profile plastic cat eyes as rumble strips in order to facilitate the commuters for reducing speed to avoid severe accidents, especially near schools, Mosques, Hospitals etc.

Presently installation of Aluminum Cat Eyes/Rumble strips has been stopped to use as speed breaker. However, it is also clarified that two type of cat eyes being used in Islamabad, one is 3M plastic cat eyes of size 100x100x27mm which is recommended to reduce the speed and other is road studs which is recommended as divider, not as a speed reducer.

**Mr. Ijaz Ahmed Shah:** One Model Addiction Treatment & Rehabilitation Centre (MATRC) Hyderabad was inaugurated by Director General, Anti-Narcotics Force on 17th September 2020. Provincial Government of Sindh has allocated running expenditure of Rs. 15.640 Million for the financial year 2020-2021. It consists of 50 beds for patients including male, female and children addicts. The MATRCs provides free of cost treatment, boarding and lodging facilities to the drug addicts including female and juvenile.

**Mr. Mohammad Azam Khan Swati:** (a) Main Line-I (ML-I) is the main railway corridor connecting Karachi seaport to the Northern side of the Pakistan up to Peshawar which does not touch Balochistan.

(b) Apart from ML-I being the Early Harvest Project of CPEC, the long term projects of CPEC include major rail connectivity project in Balochistan which will connect Gwadar to Mastung *via* Turbat, Panjgur and Basima. Other line will connect Gwadar to Jacobabad *via* Basima and Khuzdar. The detail feasibility study was completed in year 2019 at a cost of PKR 149 millions. In this regard Pakistan Railway has already acquired land in Gwadar to establish railway station and container yard. Once the ML-I project enters into its execution phase, Pakistan Railway will take up the construction of Gwadar-Mastung & Basima-Jacobabad lines with the Chinese authorities at JCC level. At the first stage, preliminary design of the project will be completed which will lead to its construction either through PPP/BOT or Chinese funding.

(c) At present two trains *i.e.* 39 up/40 Dn (Jaffar Express) and 349 Up/350 Dn (Chaman Mixed Passenger) are running on daily basis on the route of Quetta Peshawar Cantt. – Quetta and Quetta Chaman – Quetta respectively.

2. The Jaffar Express comprises of all classes *i.e.* Air Conditioned/Sleeper, Air Conditioned/Business, Air Conditioned/Standard and Economy along-with services of Dining Car. These services are catering to the needs of the passengers travelling on this route.

3. One major train 23-Up/24-Dn Akbar Express is still suspended which will be restored in due course of time on availability of resources.
