CONSIDERATION OF ADMISSIBILITY OF ADJOURNMENT MOTIONS

3. Admissibility of the following Adjournment Motions will be determined:-

- (i) **Adj. Motion No. 1 (11-261/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Mian Muhammad Ateeq Sheikh to discuss the unjustified over billing to the domestic as well as commercial consumers by MEPCO in order to cover huge losses.
- (ii) **Adj. Motion No. 2 (14-261/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Sherry Rehman to discuss the lifting of moratorium on new gas connections by the Prime Minister only to the Constituencies of his family members whereas the request of the Government of Sindh for provision of gas connections has been dismissed by the Government.
