### **CONSIDERATION OF ADMISSIBILITY OF ADJOURNMENT MOTIONS**

3. Admissibility of the following Adjournment Motions will be determined:-

- (i) **Adj. Motion No. 1(2-269/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Col. (R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi to discuss the non-construction of Burma Pull situated on Lehtrar road in Islamabad, which was damaged in 2011.
- (ii) **Adj. Motion No. 2(3-269/2017-M)**, notice given of by Senator Mian Muhammad Ateeq Shaikh to discuss the illegal practices of DISCOs about passing on the impact of the inefficiency in power sector amounting to Rs. 131 billion to power consumers.
