2. **SENATOR MUHAMMAD TALHA MAHMOOD**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Cabinet Secretariat, to move under sub-rule (1) of rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill to provide for the proper administration and management of the Islamabad Club [The Islamabad Club Administration and Management Bill, 2017], introduced by Senator Mohammad Azam Khan Swati, on 21st August, 2017, may be extended for a further period of twenty working days with effect from 28th November, 2017.

COMMENCED RESOLUTION

9. Further consideration of the following resolution moved by Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini on 20th November, 2017:-

"This House recommends that the Government should encourage manufacturing of Solar Cells within the country by reducing Taxes and GST on the same."

DEFERRED RESOLUTIONS

10. **SENATOR SEHAR KAMRAN** to move the following resolution:-

"Cognizant of the fact that maritime industry is a dynamic component in the socio-economic configuration of a maritime nation;

Realizing that Pakistan has a great strategic location and is blessed with a long coastline and abundant maritime resources which have not yet been utilized to its full potential;

Mindful of the fact that with the onset of CPEC, maritime activities in Pakistan will increase manifold and the cooperation between ports and shipping industry would become more important for systematic development of maritime sector of the country;

Recognizing the importance of maritime sector in the country's economy, this House recommends that an over-arching coordinating body namely **"The Pakistan Maritime Authority."** Should be established to help resolve governance and communication issues amongst various departments, sectors and Ministries, to ensure adherence to policy guidelines, timely planning for anticipated events and prevention of miscommunication and information gaps which will ultimately serve to bolster the country's economy."

11. SENATOR BAZ MUHAMMAD KHAN to move the following resolution:-

"The House recommends that the Government should make arrangements to set up a branch of National Bank of Pakistan at Mangal Mela of Tehsil Domail in District Bannu."

12. SENATOR MOHSIN AZIZ to move the following resolution:-

"The House recommends that the Government should make foolproof security arrangements for the pilgrims going to Iran by road via Taftan border crossing."

**WINDING UP OF DISCUSSION ON THE
ADMITTED ADJOURNMENT MOTIONS**

(R) Syed Tahir Hussain Mashhadi on 1st November, 2017, and discussed in the House on 22nd November, 2017, regarding the increase in prices of petroleum products which has placed extra burden on the poor segments of society.

Minister for Commerce and Textile to wind up the discussion on the admitted adjournment motion moved by Senator Mian Muhammad Ateeq Shaikh on 31st October, 2017, and discussed in the House on 24th November, 2017, regarding the non-profitability of FTAs with China, non-utilization of concessions granted by China under the first phase of these agreements, need to review the existing FTA agreements which are not promoting value added exports and the serious concerns regarding the promotion of local industry of Pakistan.

- iv) regarding the nomination of Member IRSA from Sindh which is not being made by the Federal Government despite writing of letter by the Chief Minister of Sindh to the Federal Government **(raised by Senator Karim Ahmed Khawaja on 20th November, 2017).**
- v) regarding the kidnaping of Mr. Nasir Abbas Sherazi, General Secretary of Majlis Wahdat-e-Muslimeen Pakistan (MWM) from WAPDA Town, Lahore, reportedly by the Police **(raised by Senator Kamil Ali Agha, on 22nd November, 2017).**
- vi) regarding the advertisements of Black Friday in the electronic media which amounts to hurting the religious sentiments of Muslims as there are number of verses in the Holy Quran about the sanctity of Friday **(raised by Senator Taj Haider, on 22nd November, 2017).**
- vii) regarding the less number of entry / exit points at Motorway Toll Plaza, Peshawar, which results into long queues especially on weekends. **(raised by Senator Syed Shibli Faraz, on 22nd November, 2017).**
