## Report No. 57 (2017)

I, Chairman of the Committee on Rules of Procedure and Privileges, have the honour to present report of the Committee on Privilege motion No. 2(269)/2017-M, moved by Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah, regarding non-implementation of the recommendations of subcommittee on Performance of PIA, by the Aviation Division, after the lapse of seven months, which were adopted by the House on 16.3.2017.

The details of the issue before the committee were that Senator Syed Muzafar Hussain Shah moved Privilege motion No. 2(269)/2017-M, stating therein that subcommittee on Performance of PIA made some recommendations to the Aviation Division which were adopted by the House on 16.3.2017 and communicated to the Aviation Division. The Division did not implement those recommendations even after the lapse of seven months. The Honourable Chairman Senate held the motion in order and referred the same to the Committee on Rules of Procedure and Privileges for looking into and proposing appropriate action in the matter. The committee discussed the matter in its meetings held on 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2018, 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 19<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. The Secretary and other concerned officers of Aviation Division were summoned to appear before the committee and explain their position in the matter.



4. The Aviation Division informed through working papers that they received report of the sub-committee of the Senate Special Committee on performance of PIA on 17<sup>th</sup> March, 2017, which was forwarded to PIACL for para wise comments on the recommendations therein. A copy of the brief on the recommendations of that committee was sent to the Senate Secretariat on 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2017. The PIACL complied with most of the said recommendations. It was also informed that a meeting of the Senate Special Committee on performance of PIA was convened on 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 wherein a presentation was given on the recommendations made by the sub-committee and action taken thereon. The presentation in connection with implementation of recommendations of the sub-committee was given to the full committee and it was assumed that there was no further need to inform the Senate Secretariat about the same as a comprehensive clarification was given in that presentation. It was also informed that no further communication was received from the Senate Secretariat in connection with those recommendations.

- 5. The Secretary Aviation Division stated that most of the recommendations of that committee were implemented. He informed that the Advisor to the Prime Minister on Aviation informed the committee that there were some administrative issues due to which some of the recommendations could not be implemented.
- 6. In the meeting of this committee held on 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, the Chairman committee informed that he received a communication from the mover wherein he had stated that he was satisfied over the action taken on the said recommendations and explanation given by the concerned quarters due to which he did not intend to pursue the matter further. The mover requested the committee to dispose off the motion.
- 7. As the mover was satisfied and did not intend to press the motion, the committee disposed off the same with the recommendation that the House may also disposed it off accordingly.
