2. **SENATOR ABDUL REHMAN MALIK**, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, to present interim report of the Standing Committee on a point of public importance raised by Senator Muhammad Javed Abbasi on 21st January, 2019, regarding killing of four people by a team of Counter Terrorism Department (CTD) officials near Sahiwal on 19th January, 2019.
