REVISED NOTICE

Reference this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 19th February, 2019. The meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Power will be held on 26th February, 2019 (Tuesday) at 02:30 p.m. in Committee Room No. 1, Parliament House, Islamabad. **In case of the Senate Session in the evening, the meeting will be held at 11:30 a.m.**

2. The agenda before the Committee would be as under:-
- i) Implementation status of the recommendations of the Committee made in its meetings held on 15-01-2019 and 06-02-2019.
 - ii) Briefing by the Power Division on the following:-
 - a) Capacity Charges being paid to the IPPs & others along with detail of the capital expenditure (CAPEX) per megawatt in dollars of all of them and the reasons for variations.
 - b) Heat rate as notified by NEPRA and that as being reflected in the Balance Sheets of the IPPs & others.
 - c) The yearly profit being earned by the IPPs & others as per the balance sheets and what Internal Rate of Return (IPR) it amounts to. The payback period of all IPPs to be calculated as per the Balance Sheets after the Commercial Operation Date (COD).
 - iii) A comprehensive briefing by the QESCO, K-Electric and NTDC covering all aspects of division / district wise electricity matters of Balochistan including the following:-
 - a) Last 5 years feeder wise demand, supply, consumption, recovery, line losses, load shedding schedule, non-receivables, bad debts and the no go areas.
 - b) Steps taken during the past 5 years for up-gradation of the transmission and distribution systems.
 - c) Projects that are underway as well as future plans/projects for betterment and improvement of the system.
 - iv) Briefing on the posting/transfer of grade 16 and above officers of PESCO, TESCO and GEPCO during the last 3 years along with reasons thereof in the cases of premature posting/transfer of the officers.
 - v) Briefing on the non-provision of electricity connections by the IESCO to the residents of various localities in Islamabad because of non-issuance of NOC by the CDA in this regard.
 - vi) Any other item with permission of the Chair.

2. The Members are requested to kindly note the change and make it convenient to attend the meeting.
