l, Chairman of the Senate Standing Committee on Power, have the honour to present report on the subject matter of "Point of Public Importance raised by Senator Aurangzeb Khan regarding appointment of staff for the maintenance of Solar Tube Wells installed in FATA" in the Senate in its sitting held on 14th November, 2018. The Chairman Senate referred the matter to the Standing Committee on Power for consideration and report.

3. The Committee took up the subject matter in its meeting held on 27th December, 2018. The following members of the Committee/Mover attended the meeting:-

4. Senator Aurangzeb Khan, briefed the Committee regarding "Appointment of staff for the maintenance of Solar Tube Wells installed in FATA"

and stated that, being un-attended, the Solar Tube Wells installed in FATA are prone to theft and damage as there is no staff employed for the purpose. He emphasized the need to appoint staff to guard, protect and look after such expensive installations from theft, damage, etc.

- 5. The Secretary Power Division briefed the Committee that FATA Secretariat looks after these schemes directly. The Committee decided that in the next meeting the provincial authorities of KPK and FATA Secretariat may be summoned to brief the Committee on the issue.
- 6. Subsequently the said matter was taken up for further consideration in the meeting of the Committee held on 6th February, 2019. The following Members of the Committee and the Mover attended the meeting:-

- 7. The Additional Secretary, Power Division briefed the Committee that it was the provincial subject. The Secretary, Irrigation Department, KPK, also briefed the Committee on the issue and said that Solar Tube Wells installed in FATA were handed over to the local community. Now it's the local community who is responsible to look after the operation, repair and maintenance of these Tube Wells.
- 8. In view of the above mentioned reply of the Additional Secretary, Power Division and the Secretary, Irrigation Department, KPK, Senator Aurangzeb Khan did not press the matter further. Therefore, the Committee disposed of the matter accordingly.
