  - (iii). Briefing by the M/o Finance on the increasing rates of inflation in the country;
  - (iv). Discussion with the M/o Finance and the State Bank of Pakistan (SBP) on the 40% increase of profits of the Islamic Banking Industry;
  - (v). Clarification/Briefing by the Pakistan Stock Exchange and Security Exchange Commission of Pakistan on the issue of recent PUCARS regulations of the Pakistan Stock Exchange requiring a Director in a listed company to disclose personal details of minor children, including birth I.D. documents even if the children themselves hold no shares, including reasons thereof;
  - (vi). Briefing by the FBR and the M/O Finance on the implementation status of the recommendations made by the Committee and adopted by the House on the Finance Supplementary (Second Amendment) Bill, 2019; and
