- 6. The matter of Point of Public Importance regarding lodging of illegal FIR against sitting Senator Shammim Afridi, raised by Senator Muhammad Javed Abbasi in the House on 06<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 was discussed in the meeting.
- 7. The senior police officers of the KPK, DPO Kohat and SHO of the concerned Police Station presented a detailed report on the incident.
- 8. Senator Muhammad Javed Abbasi raised a number of legal questions on lodging FIR against Senator Shammim Afridi.
- 9. The police neither could satisfy the Committee on the legal points raised by Senator Muhammad Javed Abbasi nor proved presence of Senator Shammim Afridi on the spot of incident as well.
- 10. The Committee feels that it is a proven fact beyond any doubt that the name of Senator Shamim Afridi was included in the FIR with malafide intentions which is not only a breach of privilege of a member of the Upper House of the Parliament but a criminal negligence and misuse of powers on the part of the police.
- 11. The Committee feels that the situation merits that the FIR registered against Senator Shamim Afridi be quashed through legal course of action and a departmental proceeding may be initiated against those concerned officers / officials who are responsible in this regard and a report on compliance be submitted to the Committee within 04 weeks.

10. The Chairman Committee disposed of the matter accordingly.
