SUMMARY

The Ministry endorsed the fact that the Government has upgraded 30 hospitals for the treatment of drug-resistant TB patients. Under the programmatic management of Drug-Resistant TB project, the government intends to provide treatment to the Drug-Resistant TB patients with financial support of the Global Fund for TB. For this purpose 30 sites have been selected from Karachi to Gilgit. After having a detailed clinical assessment of the patients supported by laboratories investigation, the baseline is established and subsequently 2nd line TB drugs are applied to provide relief to the patients.

For this specific programme, a portion of public sector hospitals is assigned for treatment of drug-resistant TB patients and the hospitals are up-graded with the following facilities.

- Construction/renovation of existing hospital building/structure required for management of drug resistant TB.
- Provision of furniture and fixtures for the PMDT site.
- Provision of medical equipment including, infection control equipment.
- · Provision of IT equipment for maintenance of patients' record.
- Provision of social support to the drug resistant TB patients.
- Provision of 2nd Line drugs for drug resistant TB.
- Provision of a team of health care providers

When 1st line TB drugs lose their efficacy, 2nd line TB drugs are applied for the treatment. The required treatment is costly and it continues for two years. To avoid and control the repercussions and side effects, it is supervised more minutely. National TB Control Programme has developed a special protocol for the management of these TB cases which include the following:

Diagnosis of resistant TB cases with latest machines called Xpert.

Baseline evaluation of the patients before putting them on 2nd line anti TB drugs

• Monthly clinical assessment of the MDR-TB patient.

· Periodic laboratory investigations to monitor treatment.

National TB Control Program has provided latest equipment for diagnosis and monitoring of the treatment which includes Xpert, Line probe assay, Culture & drug sensitivity testing laboratories.

National TB Control Programme with the help of WHO has evolved a system to de-centralize the management of Drug-Resistant TB. DRTB sites are located at regional level but unfortunately the sites are not sufficient to address the patients' needs. The District HQ Hospitals (DHQs) will function as satellites sites for management of drug-resistant TB patients. It also requires harmonious approach between different Federal and Provincial departments to bring the DRTB services closer to the patient residences. It requires not only resources but also ownership of the District health authorities.

RECOMMENDATION

 The Committee while endorsing the programme recommended that an inclusive, comprehensive approach should be applied to serve the drugresistant TB patients.

2) The Committee also advised that periodic check on the programme and feedback mechanism are all the more essential elements to monitor success of the programme. For this purpose the Committee directed to draw a baseline and devise metrics to evaluate the success in qualitative and quantitative terms. It should be programmed as a live document with a periodic assessment to mend the weaknesses of the programme. Annexure of the selected sites under this programme is also attached.
