

Senator Kalsoom Parveen, Mover of the Resolution, during the course of meeting expressed her concern over unemployment in the country resulting in over-age of candidates when they apply for job opportunities. She said that two years age relaxation should be afforded to candidates applying against posts of grade 16, 17 and 18 in the federal government. Dr. Pervez Ahmed Khan, Special Secretary Establishment Division apprised that committee that,

in federal government departments, already age relaxation was admissible to different categories of candidates belonging to Schedules Casts, Budhist Community, Recognised Tribes of Tribal areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas, Sindh (R) Baluchistan, Released and Retired Officers/ persons of Armed Forces of Pakistan, government servants, disabled persons, widow, son or daughter of deceased civil servants and CSS candidates of above mentioned areas. He said that a number of age relaxations in addition to 05 years general age relaxation have already been allowed to citizen of Pakistan. However, majority of the members of the committee were convinced and expressed their satisfaction over the position explained by the Special Secretary Establishment Division. Thus the Committee disposed of the House matter with consent of the Mover.
