

REVISED NOTICE

Reference this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 20th August, 2020. A meeting of the Standing Committee on Narcotics Control will be held on 24th August, 2020 at 11:30 a.m. in Committee Room No. 4, Parliament House, Islamabad. **In case of Senate Session in the morning, the meeting will be held at 02:30 p.m.**

2. The **revised** agenda before the Committee would be as under:-
- i. Further consideration of Point of Public Importance regarding "Overall deterioration in society and lack of responsibility shown by Government" raised by Senator Muhammad Sabir Shah

 - a. Policy for issuance of License to import / export / distribution / sale of precursor chemicals with detailed list of firms involved along with list of substance over the last ten years.
 - b. Criteria for categorization of firms involved in business of precursor chemicals.
 - c. Criteria for quota allocation to pharmaceutical firms, basic / semi-basic manufacturers.
 - viii. Briefing by D.G Anti-Narcotics Force regarding the working and achievement of twenty nine police stations setup country-wide as per the following format: -
 - a. Date wise establishment of ANF police stations.
 - b. Total No. of officers and officials deployed in each ANF police station.
 - c. Date wise details regarding raids conducted to capture.
 - d. Narcotics and criminals involved in narcotics trafficking.
 - e. Quantity of seizers by each police station year-wise and its disposal.
 - ix. Any Other item with Permission of Chair.
