MOTION

Consideration of the following motion moved by Mr. Shaukat Fayaz Ahmed Tarin, Minister for Finance and Revenue, on 11th June, 2021:-

"That the Senate may make recommendations to the National Assembly on the Finance Bill, 2021, containing the Annual Budget Statement, as required under Article 73 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan."

Further discussion was commenced.

On requests from the Members, the Chairman accorded extension of one day for submission of proposals by the members.

POINT OF PUBLIC IMPORTANCE

- i. Senator Mushtaq Ahmed spoke about killing of a Pakhtoon boy by Islamabad Police. **The Chairman referred the matter to Standing Committee on Interior.** He further pointed out the incident of three murders in Jani Khail tribe who are protesting with their dead bodies in

front of Miran Shah Police Station but no one from Provincial or Federal Governments has looked into the issue. The Member further pointed out that on raising the above referred issue, by leaders of various political parties, the Deputy Commissioner, South Waziristan arrested them under section 3 of MPO and sent them to jail.

After hearing the Member, the Hon'ble Chairman Senate directed to seek a detailed report from the Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and from the Inspector General of Police, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

- ii. Senator Mian Raza Rabbani spoke about the recent statements by the Federal Ministers asking the Government of Sindh to implement Article 140A in Sindh. He was of the view that when Article 140A is not being implemented in other provinces then why demand is being made only from Sindh.
- iii. Senator Kauda Babar pointed out the written reply to his question asked from the establishment division about the criteria for appointments of Chief Secretaries in the provinces. **The Chairman referred the matter to Standing Committee concerned.**

At 07:00 p.m. the Deputy Chairman adjourned the proceedings of the House to meet again on Tuesday, the 15th June, 2021, at 04:00 p.m. which was later on changed to 5:00 p.m. in terms of Rule 23 of the Rules.
