REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE

Senator Mohsin Aziz, Chairman, Standing Committee on Interior, presented report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Pakistan Arms Ordinance, 1965 to the extent of Islamabad Capital Territory [The Pakistan Arms (Amendment) Bill, 2021].

LEGISLATIVE BUSINESS

Mazari, Minister for Human Rights, moved that the Bill to establish an effective system of protection, relief and rehabilitation of women, children and any vulnerable person against domestic violence [The Domestic Violence (Prevention and Protection) Bill, 2021], be passed.

The Motion was put to the House and the Bill was passed with amendments.

Senator Mian Raza Rabbani moved amendments in clauses 2, 3, 4, 10, 11, 21, 25 and 28 of the Bill which were carried.

Dr. Shireen M. Mazari, Minister for Human Rights, moved that the Bill to provide for the well-being, comfort and dignity of the senior citizens residing in the Islamabad Capital Territory [The Islamabad Capital Territory Senior Citizens Bill, 2021], be passed.

The Motion was put to the House and the Bill was passed with amendments.
