REVISED NOTICE

Reference this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 23rd August, 2021. The meeting of the Senate Standing Committee on Petroleum scheduled to be held on 25th August, 2021, at 2.00 p.m. in Committee Room No. 4 **will now be held on the same date and time in Committee Room No. 1 instead of Committee Room No. 4** with the following agenda:-

- (i) Briefing about the **LPG** cylinder blast in Gujranwala on 8th August, 2021 and the safety measures adopted for the use of CNG and LPG in vehicles.
- (ii) Briefing about the spot purchasing of LNG by PLL and PSO during the months of July and August, 2021.
- (iii) Briefing about the drilling for oil and gas exploration in the different parts of Kalat Division (Balochistan) and the works carried out by the companies in those areas under the CSR.
- (iv) Briefing about safe and commercially viable options in case of major future supply disruption of LNG.
- (v) Details of listed / unlisted Public Sector Oil and Gas Companies along with their management and Government of Pakistan Shareholding in each Public Sector Oil and Gas Company, under Petroleum Division.
- (vi) Further discussion about the corruption/default case of M/s Hascol Petroleum Ltd.
- (vii) Briefing about the increase in OMCs Margins and downstream sector policy revision, pending since, 1997.
- (viii) The projected indigenous Gas and Imported LNG demand of the country, available quantity, and shortfall?
- (ix) Why do RLNG consumers cannot import LNG for its own usage? And why Government of Pakistan has import LNG on behalf of RLNG consumers?
- (x) How many Firm and spot agreements have been done so far by PSO and PLL? Who will decide to import LNG on a spot/short-term basis and who will decide to cancel LNG cargo?
- (xi) Why has the Private sector not yet been given an opportunity to import private LNG?
- (xii) Which sectors are paying the full price of LNG and which sectors are consuming LNG on subsidized rates?
- (xiii) Is Government of Pakistan and Private LNG terminal capacity will be fully utilized in the upcoming winter season and what will be Government's role in it?
- (xiv) What is the timeline for new LNG terminal commencement?
- (xvi) Any other item with permission of the chair.
