**[Under Rule 194(1)]**

1. Senator Muhammad Talha Mehmood, Chairman, Standing Committee on Finance, Revenue and Economic Affairs, moved under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the Federal Board of Revenue Act, 2007 [The Federal Board of Revenue (Amendment) Bill, 2020], introduced by Senator Kauda Babar, may be extended for a period of thirty working days with effect from 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.

**The Motion was put to the House and requisite extension was granted.**

2. Senator Muhammad Talha Mehmood, Chairman, Standing Committee on Finance, Revenue and Economic Affairs, moved under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on a Resolution moved by Senator Syed Faisal Ali Subzwari on 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2021, recommending the Government to give special tax exemptions to the small traders and low salaried class of Karachi and Hyderabad, may be extended for a period of fifteen working days with effect from 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

Senator Walid Iqbal, Chairman, Standing Committee on Human Rights, moved under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the Bill further to amend the National Commission on the Rights of Child Act, 2017 [The National Commission on the Rights of Child (Amendment) Bill, 2020], introduced by Senator Faisal Javed, may be extended for a period of sixty working days with effect from 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.

Senator Ejaz Ahmad Chaudhary, Chairman, Standing Committee on Narcotics Control moved under sub-rule (1) of Rule 194 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Senate, 2012, that the time for presentation of report of the Committee on the subject matter of starred question No. 15 asked by Senator Bahramand Khan Tangi regarding number of drug rehabilitation centers established in the country during last two years, may be extended for a period of sixty days with effect from 12<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

**CALLING ATTENTION NOTICES**

1. Senator Nuzhat Sadiq drew attention of the Minister for Aviation Division, towards the difficulties being faced by Pakistanis due to over-booking and cancellation of flights of various Airlines.

**Minister for Aviation Division, made a statement and the Calling Attention Notice was disposed of by the Chairman.**

2. Senator Mohsin Aziz drew attention of the Minister for Aviation Division, towards the serious construction flaws in the building of New Islamabad International Airport with particular reference to a recent occurrence of roof collapse on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2021.

**Minister for Aviation Division, made a statement and the Calling Attention Notice was disposed of by the Chairman.**

#### POINTS OF PUBLIC IMPORTANCE

1. Leader of the Opposition spoke about the recent increase in the petroleum products which will result into further inflation.

Following Members spoke on the issue:-

1. Senator Mian Raza Rabbani.
2. Senator Mushtaq Ahmed.
3. Senator Sherry Rehman

Opposition benches staged walkout as protest against rise in petroleum prices and absence of the Minister for Finance to respond to the issue.

2. Senator Muhammad Tahir Bizenjo pointed out that Leaders of the United Tribes All Parties Nushki have urged the government to abandon the Burj Aziz Dam project, saying it would "convert agriculture lands of Nushki district into a desert and deprive people of their livelihood".
3. Senator Gurdeep Singh drew attention of the House towards an incident of killing of a Member of Sikh community at Charsaddah Road Peshawar. He further pointed out target killings of almost 10 members of Sikh community in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in various incidents. He demanded that the Government should constitute a Committee to probe into the mastermind behind the killing of members of Sikh community in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

After hearing the Member, the Hon'ble Chairman Senate directed to seek detailed report of the incident mentioned by the Member in particular and overall incidents of killing of Sikh community in general from IGP KPK.
