MOTION

28. DEFERRED RESOLUTION

29. SENATOR MANZOOR AHMED, to move the deferred resolution:-

"Cognizant of the fact that Parliaments are held in highest esteem and decorum around the democratic world as the supreme institution of a nation;

Observing that Parliament of Pakistan represents the country and its people at the international fora and therefore it is imperative to accord due value, decorum and protocol to the custodians of the House of the Parliament while on official visits abroad;

Noting that apart from high public office holders in the federation, Chief Ministers' Secretariats of all four provinces also have official aircraft as well as helicopters to facilitate their travel;

The Senate of Pakistan recommends that the Government may provide a dedicated aircraft to the Parliament of Pakistan, or an aircraft may be procured from Senate`s own budget, for the use of Senate of Pakistan, as it would save significant travel time and costs while ensuring much needed travel facilitation within the country and abroad."

RESOLUTIONS

30. SENATOR MUSHTAQ AHMED, to move the following resolution:-

"The Senate of Pakistan expresses tribute to iconic late Hurriyat Leader Syed Ali Shah Geelani for his life-long struggle for justice, freedom and self-determination of Kashmiri people against the Indian illegal occupation of Jammu and Kashmir; Strongly condemns the suppressive act of Indian Government of snatching of the mortal remains of Syed Ali Shah Geelani from his family;

Denounce the UN-ceremonial burial of great leader in gross violation of the principles of human rights reflecting rage, tyranny and barbarianism of Indian occupied forces;

Recommends that the Government of Pakistan should continue to take up the said matter at all national and international fora including UN;

Urges upon the international community to take notice of Indian Government`s callous and inhuman handling of the situation violating all civil and human rights norms in the occupied valley;

Call upon the Indian Government to stop the harassment of the family of Syed Ali Shah Geelani and drop the orchestrated cases against them;

Demands that Government of India should immediately release the detained Kashmiri political leaders and youth in arbitrary detention in jails across India; and

Urges upon the Indian Government to allow access to UN Observers, International Human Rights and Humanitarian Organizations as well as International Media into IIOJK to assess the ground realities."

31. SENATOR SEEMEE EZDI ,to move the following resolution:-

"This House recommends that in view of growing rate of global warming throughout the world, the Government should formulate a National Climate Change Emergency Action Plan to address the growing menace of climate change at all levels in collaboration with local and provincial Government as well as other stakeholders."

"The House expresses deep sorrow and condolences on the demise of the great patriotic Pakistan's nuclear scientist Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan.

The House acknowledges with honor the exemplary role of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan as the father of the Pakistan nuclear program, who made the security of Pakistan invincible by transforming Pakistan into the first nuclear power in the Muslim World. The House appreciates the role of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan as man of honor for his country and Islam who established many educational institutions, hospitals and mosques throughout the country.

In view of his unprecedented and untiring efforts in the security and service of Pakistan, Islam and humanity, the House recommends the following:

- i) The Government may establish a University of Science and Technology in the name of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan;
- ii) The Government may appoint a Chair in the Ghulam Ishaq Khan University in the name of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan; and
- iii) The life and struggles of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan may be included in the national educational curriculum at Federal and Provincial levels."
